The following investigation was conducted by SA LEONARD V. DAHL and SA CRAWFORD F. WILLIAMS on 5/9/68:

AT CHARLOTTE, N. C.

MILLARD McNEIL, owner of the Complimentary Dinner Club, Inc., 2101-17 Independence Blvd., who resides at 531-C Colonade, was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY which was taken in late 1/68 or early 2/68 and was asked if he had anyone working for him who appeared to resemble the photograph. He advised that one of his employees, FRED E.NAGENGAST. looks similar to the individual in the photograph but was not identical. He advised that NAGENGAST has been in the Charlotte area at least since Christmas, 1967, and is originally from Mich. He is a musician and has been working with the Complimentary Dinner Club, Inc. for about a week or ten days as a part-time employee. He said NAGENGAST moved into his apartment with him last week and is living at 531-C Colonade. He advised that while there are some features of the photograph which resemble NAGENGAST, they are definitely not identical.

PATRICIA MOSER, 1130 Robinhood Circle, who is employed at the Complimentary Dinner Club, Inc., advised that FRED NAGENGAST has been known to her since before Christmas, 1967, and has been in the Charlotte area for about one year. He came to Charlotte from Atlanta, Ga., and prior to that time he lived in Mich. He is a musician and has been employed by Complimentary Dinner Club, Inc. for about a week or two. She advised that the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY is not identical with NAGENGAST but that they do have some similar features.



Benny Jack, P.O. Box 458 Hillsboro, N.C., tel. 732-4445, was interviewed at North State Pyrophollite Co. where he had driven a truck to deliver material, 5/9/68. He said he wanted to furnish the following information:

About 3 weeks previously he had been gassing his truck at J. B. Honeywutt Service Station, W-S Rd., west of G'boro. A man and woman in a black 1959 Ford stopped at the station. The man made inquiry of a young man who works at the station part-time if he knew where he might get a job. He said he had to make about \$100 per week. The man had 2 small children in the car with him and the woman. The young fellow at the station could give him no help as **XX** far as a prospective job was concerned.

The woman said she was from Memphis, the man said he was from Mississippi. Mr. Mack did not notice what kind of license was on the car. He did not place any signific ance in the incident until the latest photo of James Earl Ray was shown on television the night of 5/7/68. He then thought the man at the service station bore some resemblance to Ray.

He described the unknown man as: W/M, This brown hair, 5'10" to 5'11", wearing black trousers. The woman was W/F, possibly wearing shorts, long brown hair, had two small childreh.
