- Referenced Butel reads as follows:

During automobile trip of subject RAY and CHARLES STEIN departing Los Angeles on 12/15/67 and arriving New Orleans on 12/17/67, subject RAY made about six telephone calls from various pay stations in Texas.

They traveled via automobile on Interstate 10 through El Paso to Van Horn, Texas, and went south on Route 90 to San Antonio, then Route 90 or Interstate 10 to Houston, Texas, and to New Orleans.

Each office should check with telephone company and determine the long distance calls placed at each public telephone on the above mentioned routes during period of 12/15, 16, and 17, 1967, and have each call checked out.

On 4/30/68, Mrs. HELEN ORNELAS, Service Representative, West Texas Telephone Company, Pecos, Texas, made available duplicate bills on pay stations from Van Horn, Valentine, and Sierra Blanca, Texas.

Noted that these bills reflect the telephone numbers of the individuals receiving the telephone calls from the pay stations in the above mentioned communities. As noted above, the pertinent dates are 12/15, 16, and 17/67. The teletype codes of the respective offices have been added to these duplicate bills, indicating the telephone numbers to be checked out by the various offices receiving this airtel.

On 5/2/68, Mrs. A. M. WITTNE, 901 Dabney, Corpus Christi, Texas, advised as follows.

She was formerly employed by Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, 4th Floor, Milam Building, San Antonio, Texas. This company had in its office an album of professional insurance claimants, which she believes was compiled and maintained by Southwest Index Bureau. Recently upon seeing newspaper and television photographs of subject, it seemed to her she had observed a photograph in the album of professional insurance claimants at the Liberty Mutual Insurance Company office which was that of subject, or someone who looked very similar to him. Further, she thought possibly the name JAMES EARL RAY was included in the above index and album.

On 5/8/68, Mr. J. EDGAR BOWDEN, Claims Manager, Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, Room 411 Milam Building, San Antonio, Texas, advised SA DEAN N. LLOYD that review of indices for JAMES EARL RAY and known aliases was negative. BOWDEN suggested that the Fraud and Arson Bureau and the Southwest Index Bureau, both located in Dallas, be contacted inasmuch as they maintain a national index of professional claimants.

It was suggested by the Bureau that consideration be given to requesting local police departments to display photograph of RAY to witnesses in unsolved robberies during the pertinent period and until apprehended.

Accordingly, all Resident Agents will comply with the above suggestion during regular contacts with police departments. A supply of Wanted Flyer No. 404 942 G is available in the Dallas Office, if needed. Submit memo for file upon completion of contacts.

For your information a review of the unsolved bank robbery matters of the Dallas Office, during the pertinent period, has been made with regard to captioned subject being a possible suspect; however, in the future and until subject RAY has been apprehended, he should be considered by you as a possible suspect in any new bank robbery matter.

The following investigation was conducted on
5/14/68, by SA RAYMOND M. LESTER, JR:

AT DUMAS, TEXAS

FRANK HUDSON, Chief of Police, Dumas Police Department, and JOHN EASLEY, Sheriff, Moore County Sheriff's Department, advised upon viewing Identification Order number 4182, that they could not recall having ever seen a person resembling JAMES EARL RAY residing at Dumas, Texas. They advised there is only one Texaco Service Station located on the west side of Highway 287, which would be the highway a person would travel on en route from Denver, Colorado south to Amarillo, Texas. They advised this service station is operated by PHIL BURNS, and is called the PHIL BURNS Texaco. This station is located at the intersection of the East-West Highway, from Hartley, Texas, to Stinnett, Texas, and Highway 287.

PHIL BURNS, owner and manager, PHIL BURNS Texaco, North Dumas Avenue, advised upon viewing a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, as shown on Identification Order number 4182, that he could not recall having ever had any person who resembled RAY, in his employ at that service station. He said all of his service attendants had been with him for at least the past six months, and he certainly knows nothing of credit cards being stolen from a customer's automobile. Mr. BURNS advised that normally whenever someone would have a complaint such as this, they would either contact the station, or the Texaco Company to make a complaint. He said he had not been contacted by Mrs. COOGAN, nor by the Texaco Company concerning the credit cards supposedly stolen from her purse while she was doing business at his

Mr. BURNS advised that upon viewing the Identification Order number 4182, that possibly someone might state that one of his service station attendants, J. W. MC INTYRE, could possibly resemble the photograph taken in 1963 of JAMES EARL RAY. He stated however, that MC INTYRE is only about 25 years old, and has been in his continuous employ for the past eight months.

~~J. W. MC INTYRE~~ 506 East Eighth Street, Dumas, was interviewed at the PHIL BURNS Texaco Station at which time it was noted that he bore some resemblance to the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY taken in 1968. MC INTYRE stated he was 27 years old and has not been away from Dumas during the past eight or nine months. He was positively eliminated as being identical to JAMES EARL RAY by comparison of fingerprint patterns.

On 5/14/68, Mr. JOSEPH CROW, Manager, City Center Motel, 3520 Camp Bowie Boulevard, telephonically contacted the Resident Agency, advising that a white male, who rented a room at the motel on the previous night, bore a resemblance to what he recalled was the appearance of the murderer of Martin Luther King. This individual, HAROLD CARMIKLE, prepaid \$7.20 for Room 214, on the previous evening. His registration card reflected no street address but listed city and state as Memphis, Tennessee. CARMIKLE advised CROW that he was in Fort Worth seeking employment as a truck driver. He carried no luggage and about 11:30 AM of this date, he walked out of the office of the motel, across Camp Bowie Street and over to Montgomery street, continuing to walk south on Montgomery street, toward the East-West Freeway. CROW presumed that CARMIKLE was headed toward the Freeway to hitch hike out of the city. CROW had not seen this person previously and has no further information as to where he may have went. CROW described the person as about 30-35 years of age, 6 feet tall, 175 pounds, dark brown or black hair which was curly in front, blue eyes, tattoo of a girl's head on upper left arm near shoulder and the name "Lorraine", in script, on upper right arm. He was wearing a bright yellow sport shirt, dark brown pants and black loafers when he left the motel. Upon observing an IO, #4182, pertaining to JAMES EARL RAY and ERIC STARVO GALT, CROW advised that there "is a similarity" between CARMIKLE and captioned subject. CROW stated that should he obtain additional information concerning CARMIKLE, or should CARMIKLE reappear at the motel, He would notify the FBI immediately. He suggested that CARMIKLE may have stopped at a bar on Montgomery street on his way to the Freeway.

On the same date, Mr. EDWARD LYNN, Cafe Manager at the City Center Motel, advised he had engaged HAROLD CARMIKLE in casual conversation while CARMIKLE drank a cup of coffee before leaving the motel. LYNN described CARMIKLE almost identically to the description given by CROW, except LYNN stated that CARMIKLE had a tattoo of a girl's head on his left forearm and the name "Lorraine" or "Laverne", in script, tattooed on the upper right arm. CARMIKLE spoke with no recognizable accent. LYNN did not recall obtaining any information from CARMIKLE other than that given above by CROW. CARMIKLE did state he had been drinking in some bar, address unrecalled, on Camp Bowie Boulevard on the previous night and further that he lived in and was familiar with West Memphis, Tennessee. Upon observing IO #4182, LYNN stated that CARMIKLE "resembled" JAMES EARL RAY, but would commit himself no further.

Immediately after interview of the foregoing persons, attempts to locate CARMIKLE in several of the bars on camp Bowie and on Montgomery Streets and on the East-West Freeway met with negative results.

DONALD BRUCE LIVELY, Investments, 1600 LTV Tower, residing at 7215 Palado Street, telephone AD 9-5447, Dallas, related that the only person he recalls receiving telephone calls from in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico is RAY CARSON. He said he vacationed in Puerto Vallarta for about two weeks in about October, 1967 and for about three weeks in early February, 1968. While vacationing there he met CARSON, who was a free lance real estate broker. Subsequent to his first visit to Mexico, he received about five or six telephone calls from CARSON in regard to the possibility of LIVELY's buying a house in Puerto Vallarta. The purchase was not consummated, and he later learned that CARSON had been deported from Mexico for some reason. The last he heard of CARSON he was in Costa Rica.

During the first vacation he took in Puerto Vallarta, LIVELY rented a house known as Casa Los Rapidos and on the second vacation, he rented a house known as Casa Amorillo. CARSON also lived in a private residence but did not have a telephone in his home.

LIVELY viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated this person was completely unknown to him.

Enclosed for the Bureau are the originals of an envelope and letter postmarked May 1, 1968, at Dallas, Texas, addressed: "Mr. LOEB, Mayor of Memphis, Memphis, Tennessee". This letter reads as follows:

"I didn't mean to kill Rev. LUTHER KING. They hired me to shoot him in the leg and when he stupid over I accidental kill him. Brother A said he would pay me \$300 cash and if Rev. KING was wounded they would get a hole lot of money and would give me 5000. Now they will pay me no more. 3 men hired me called each other Bro A Mr. B and Mr. T.

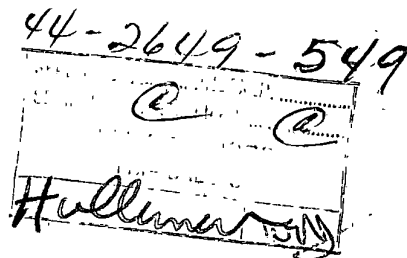
"By the time you gets this I will be out of the country. Hope you gets the 3 men that hired me. They are the guilty ones. You are looking for the wrong man. I am white but not a white man Black man hired me."

This letter was made available today by Inspector N. E. ZACHARY, Homicide Bureau, Memphis Police Department, who stated he had received it today from the Mayor's Office. Several names written in ink on the back of the envelope are names that were written by someone in the Mayor's Office and have no connection with this letter.

A Xerox copy of this letter is enclosed for the Dallas Office; however, no investigation is being requested of Dallas until such time as the Bureau has compared the handwriting with known handwriting of subject JAMES EARL RAY.
