At 12:35 a.m., 4/18/68, Raymond Higgins, 300 East Worthington Avenue, Charlotte, North Carolina, telephonically contacted Duty Supervisor SA Richard F. Bates to advise that he had just observed an individual at Robertson's Drive-In Restaurant, South Boulevard, Charlotte, whom he felt was possibly Eric Starvo Galt. According to Higgins, this individual was accompanied by a woman who spoke in a foreign tongue.

Higgins stated that he, Higgins, has patronized Robertson's Drive-In for years and knows all the regular customers, thus, when this man and woman entered, his attention was attracted to them as he knew they were not regular customers. Higgins declared he checked the newspaper photos of Galt and the unknown man bore a striking resemblance to Galt. Higgins further advised that the man's left ear was larger than his right ear.

When the couple left, Higgins followed them to an apartment house in the 1800 block of South Boulevard, Charlotte, possibly 1821 South Boulevard. He did not know what apartment they entered but described the building as renting out \$20 a week apartments.

Higgins can be reached during the day at his employment, Mitchell and Becker, 1900 block of South Boulevard.

Corcoran, whose date of birth is given as at Baltimore, Maryland, resides at 1929 Gwynn Oak Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, and listed occupation as a salesman.

The writings received in this case lack the comparability for an adequate comparison with the signature Robert J. Corcoran; however, nothing of particular cance was noted between the signature of Corcoran when compared with the writings attributed to Eric S. Galt, from such a comparison as could be made.

The Washington Field Office has forwarded this information to the Baltimore Division for further investigation and the above information was furnished to the Latent Fingerprint Section for a search of the records of the Identification Division and a subsequent comparison of any fingerprint cards located with the unidentified latents appearing on items received in this matter.

Bureau indices were searched for references to the surname "Starvo" and the following files were identified with this name.

The name Joseph Starvo is indexed to Bureau file 29-13429, and serial 57 of this file indicates that the name Joseph Starvo is one of numerous aliases of one Joseph Scavo who participated with several others in a bank swindle of approximately \$100,000 during the period August, 1948, to October, 1949. Scavo was age 26 in 1949. On April 28, 1950, in USDC, New York, Scavo was sentenced to $2\frac{1}{2}$ years.

The name Mike Starvo is indexed to Bureau file 100-3-38-15, which file contains an El Paso report dated May 26, 1941, entitled "Communist Activities in New Mexico, IS-C." This report contained a list of 21 persons possibly connected with communist activities; one of them was identified as a Mike Starvo reported to be a miner and a member of the United Mine Workers of America. His whereabouts in May of 1941 were not known to the postmistress or Chief of Police at Gallup, New Mexico, his last residence.

Bureau file 64-200, SUB 221, SUB 6, serial 11, enclosure, page 25, contains a list of alleged Communist Party members in Mexico, one of these identified as a Mike Starvo. On April 26, 1954, El Paso Office reported a name check of its files made at request of the INS, El Paso, and there was no record on a Mike Starvo in the El Paso FBI files.

Bureau file 100-355154, serial 31, is a report dated July 5, 1956, entitled "Raymond Rose, IS-R," and the name Sarah Starvo is indexed to this report. The report sets out results of a surveillance conducted on the subject Rose and it was noted during the surveillance he entered the Nola Studios, 1657 Broadway, New York City. This studio was foliad by Vincent J. Nola and his daughter, Sarah Starvo, aka, Mrs. Frank Starvo, his assistant secretary at the studio.

She said this individual was dressed in a white uniform and appeared to be an employee of Eastern Airlines. He was engaged in putting food on to airplanes. She advised one of his ears appeared to protrude as does Galt's in the photograph.

Bufiles reflect no information identifiable with this individual, and she appeared to be quite coherent and rational.
