HEARD, telephone number 366-8209, was interviewed at his place of employment, Briarwood Texaco Service Station, 5575 Interstate 55 North, Jackson, Mississippi. He was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and of the nature of the inquiry.

WORD advised that about one week ago his wife, MARY, took their five children and his Mustang automobile and left him, driving to the home of her mother in Las Vegas, Nevada. WORD subsequently found out where she was and left Jackson, Mississippi, on Wednesday, April 10, 1968, to go and get her or at least pick up the automobile which he had only made two payments on.

He stated he hitched a ride and also traveled by bus part of the way to Nevada. He stated he obtained the black Mustang convertible with a white top from his wife and drove it back to Mississippi alone. He stated he passed through Oklahoma City late Saturday afternoon.

WORD advised he arrived back in Jackson, Mississippi, Sunday night, first stopping by his place of employment and then checking into Baker Motel, Highway 49, North Jackson. He stayed in Unit Number 3 of this motel for one night. He stated he plans to live with his mother temporarily in Jackson since he and his wife are now separated.

WORD stated that the Mustang which he now has possession of was purchased by DAVID BREWER, an acquaintance of his at Jackson, Mississippi, but BREWER was unable to keep up the monthly payments and let WORD have the vehicle on February 12, 1968, letting WORD take up the payments.

WORD advised that the Mississippi License Plate which is on the Mustang now, 1968 Mississippi HB-9317, is the same license plate that has been on the vehicle since he obtained it. He stated he understands BREWER bought this license plate for a Ford Falcon but switched it to the Mustang after selling the Falcon.

WORD advised he works regularly at the Briarwood Texaco Service Station from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. six days a week and has not been off from work any this year other than the trip to Nevada mentioned above. He stated he is off each Thursday all day which is his regular day off. WORD advised he has not been in Memphis, Tennessee, or Birmingham, Alabama, during the past six months. He stated that on April 4, 1968, he was at Jackson, Mississippi. He stated he was working on a car behind the service station where he works at about 6:00 p.m. on April 4, 1968, and was talking to CLINTON BROWN, at which time he heard about Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING's being shot at Memphis, Tennessee.

Mr. JACK C. PETERS, owner, Briarwood Texaco Service Station, 5575 Interstate 55, North, Jackson, Mississippi, was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the inquiry.

PETERS advised that OSCAR M. WORD has been employed regularly by this service station for approximately one year. He stated WORD works from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. or later, six days a week. His regular day off is Thursday of each week.

PETERS stated that WORD has not been absent from work any day this year to his recollection other than the past few days when he made a trip to Nevada to obtain his 1965 black Mustang convertible with a white top, which his wife had taken, about a week ago.

PETERS advised that WORD is a steady worker, has a good reputation, and he stated he has no reason to believe WORD would be involved in any type of racial violence.

Result of examination:

The hand printing appearing on the slip of paper comprising a portion of Q124 was searched in the Anonymous Letter File without effecting an identification. Appropriate photographs have been added to this file for future reference.

The cellophane tape comprising a portion of Q124 is of common $\frac{1}{2}$ inch-wide variety, the ends of which appear to have been torn or cut unevenly.

Due to the limited nature of the questioned hand printing on Q124 and because of unexplained variations, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether the hand printing on Q124 is identical to the hand printing appearing on documents attributable to Eric S. Galt, submitted in this case. A number of significant differences were noted indicating

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr., on 4/4/68.

Eric Starvo Galt, for whom Federal process has been issued in this case, has previously claimed to work on Mississippi River boats out of St. Louis, has given a St. Louis address for his nearest relative, although no such person could be located, and the earliest address known to have been used by him was in Kansas City on 3/1/67.

No record has been found of Galt in the Missouri - Kansas area, although extensive investigation has been conducted and extensive record checks have been made.

On two occasions Galt has used the birth date but has not listed any birthplace.

Selective Service records in the State of Missouri have been checked for all registrants born A similar check was undertaken yesterday for the State of Kansas but before the check could be completed, Colonel Junior Elder, Administrative Officer of the Selective Service System for the State of Kansas, advised that he had been instructed by Colonel Daniel Omer, Deputy Director and General Counsel at Selective Service Headquarters, Washington, D. C., that no further records should be made available unless specifically authorized by General Hershey.

ACTION:

In view of the importance of this case, it is recommended that the Special Investigative Division, which maintains liaison with Selective Service Headquarters, personally contact General Hershey in order that the check of Selective Service records in Kansas can be promptly completed.

PAISLEY SAID THE PHOTO WITH EYES SHUT DOES RESEMBLE THE ERIC S. GALT WHO PURCHASED THE PAISLEY'S MUSTANG, BUT PAISLEY DID NOT CARE TO MAKE A POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION UNTIL HE COULD SEE GALT IN PERSON. PAISLEY COMMENTED IT APPEARED THAT GALT HAS PUT ON SOME WEIGHT SINCE PAISLEY SAW HIM IN AUGUST, NINETEEN SIXTYSEVEN, AS GALT'S FACE APPEARS FATTER THAN WHAT PAISLEY RECALLS. AFTER STUDYING THE PHOTO OF GALT FOR SEVERAL MINUTES, PAISLEY COMMENTED THAT THE MORE HE LOOKED AT THE PHOTO THE MORE HE BELIEVED IT WAS A PHOTO OF THE ERIC S. GALT KNOWN TO PAISLEY LAST AUGUST.

PAISLEY'S MOTHER, MRS. WILLIAM D. PAISLEY, SR., AFTER VIEWING PHOTOS OF GALT, SAID SHE CAN'T BE SURE IF THIS IS THE MAN SHE OBSERVED BUY THE PAISLEY MUSTANG IN AUGUST, NINETEEN SIXTYSEVEN, BUT TO BEST OF HER RECOLLECTION, WHICH IS ADMITTEDLY VAGUE AS SHE PAID NO ATTENTION TO THIS BUYER, THE PHOTO DID RESEMBLE THE PURCHASER, EXCEPT THE MAN IN THE PHOTO HAS A FULLER FACE THAN THE PURCHASER AND THE HAIR IN THE PHOTO IS TOO DARK. SHE SAID THE MOUTH AND NOSE IN THE PHOTO DEFINITELY REMIND HER OF THE PURCHASER.

WILLIAM DAVID PAISLEY, SR., SAID THERE IS A RESEMBLANCE BETWEEN THE MAN IN THE PHOTO (GALT) AND THE ERIC S. GALT WHO

PURCHASED PAISLEY'S NINETEEN SIXTYSIX WHITE MUSTANG IN AUGUST, NINETEEN SIXTYSEVEN. PAISLEY SAID HE COULD NOT MAKE A POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION, BUT ADDED THE MAN IN THE PHOTO HAS A FATTER FACE THAN THE ERIC S. GALT WHO BOUGHT THE MUSTANG.

CLYDE MANASCO, EMPLOYED GUN RACK, BIRMINGHAM, STATES PHOTO GALT APPEARS IDENTICAL TO MAN IN GUN RACK MARCH TWENTYSEVEN, SIXTYEIGHT, EXCEPT FACE IN PHOTO APPEARS SLIGHTLY BROADER THAN HE RECALLS.

MR. HERBERT KELLY, WHO IS EMPLOYED AS COOK AT ECONOMY ROOMING HOUSE, BIRMINGHAM, AND WHO SERVED GALT MEALS DURING PERIOD OF RESIDENCE, VIEWED TWO PHOTOGRAPHS OF ERIC STARVO GALT THIS DATE. KELLY, AFTER VIEWING, STATED "I BELIEVE THESE PHOTOGRAPHS OF GALT ARE IDENTICAL WITH THE ERIC GALT WHO RESIDED AT THIS ROOMING HOUSE. THESE PICTURES BEAR A VERY CLOSE RESEMBLANCE TO HIM." KELLY WILL NOT MAKE POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION, GIVING AS HIS REASON THAT HE DESIRES TO VIEW GALT IN PERSON BEFORE MAKING POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION.

PETER CHERPES, OWNER, ECONOMY ROOMING HOUSE, VIEWED PHOTOGRAPHS AND SAID "I BELIEVE THIS IS ERIC GALT WHO RESIDED AT MY ROOMING HOUSE. THE PHOTOGRAPHS BEAR A VERY CLOSE RESEMBLANCE TO HIM; HOWEVER, I CAN'T BE SURE UNTIL I SEE HIM IN PERSON."

ROBERT WOOD, OWNER AEROMARINE SUPPLY COMPANY, ADVISED HIS

WIFE RECEIVED AN ANONYMOUS TELEPHONE CALL THIS DATE. CALLER STATED "WE'LL KILL YOU" AND HUNG UP. WOOD AND WIFE BELIEVE THIS TO BE WORK OF CRANK. IF ADDITIONAL CALLS ARE RECEIVED, HE WILL REQUEST AN UNLISTED TELEPHONE AND ADVISE POLICE.

LOGICAL RIFLE RANGES IN BIRMINGHAM AREA CHECKED WITHOUT DETERMINING ANY INFORMATION INDICATING GALT UTILIZED RANGES FOR SIGHTING-IN RIFLE.

THE RECORDS OF UNITED ELECTRONICS LAB, A TRAINING SCHOOL LOCATED AT TWO SEVEN ONE SEVEN SEVENTH AVENUE SOUTH, BIRMINGHAM, WERE CHECKED FOR THE NAMES KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN UTILIZED BY THE SUBJECT. RECORDS OF THE DAY SCHOOL, EVENING SCHOOL, AND CORRESPONDENCE DIVISION WERE NEGATIVE.

BIRMINGHAM IS IMMEDIATELY CHECKING OUT LEADS RECEIVED FROM INDIVIDUALS IN AREA WHO ALLEGED THEY HAVE SEEN PERSONS RESEMBLING GALT. WHERE APPROPRIATE, LEADS HAVE BEEN SET OUT TO OTHER OFFICES AND THUS FAR NO POSITIVE INFORMATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED INDICATING WHEREABOUTS OF GALT.

U. S. ATTORNEY MACON WEAVER ADVISED HE RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL FROM DISTRICT ATTORNEY EARL MORGAN FOLLOWING CONFERENCE WITH COUNTY COMMISSIONER. MORGAN DESIRED TO KNOW WHY BIRMINGHAM WAS

CHOSEN FOR FILING OF COMPLAINT. WEAVER CALLED ATTORNEY GENERAL, WHO ADVISED HIM DECISION RE LOCATION WAS MADE BY FBI. ATTORNEY GENERAL SAID HE ASSUMED BIRMINGHAM CHOSEN BECAUSE IT WAS PLACE WHERE FIRST OVERT ACT OF CONSPIRACY OCCURRED. WEAVER CONVEYED THIS INFORMATION TO DISTRICT ATTORNEY, WHO APPEARED SATISFIED. IT WAS DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S PRIME CONCERN FILING OF PROCESS IN BIRMINGHAM MIGHT REFLECT ON BIRMINGHAM'S REPUTATION.

INFORMATION RE NEWS MEDIA

MR. PAISLEY, SR., A RESPECTED AND REPUTABLE BIRMINGHAM LUMBER COMPANY SALES MANAGER, COMMENTED THAT SINCE YESTERDAY AFTERNOON HE HAS BEEN CONTINUALLY HARASSED BY NEWS REPORTERS, INCLUDING TOM LANKFORD OF "THE BIRMINGHAM NEWS," GENE STEVENS OF "UPI," AND UNKNOWN NEWSMEN FROM LOS ANGELES AND NEW YORK. STEVENS TOLD PAISLEY, SR., THAT EVEN THOUGH PAISLEY HAD BEEN TOLD BY THE FBI NOT TO TALK TO NEWSMEN, PAISLEY, SR., DID NOT HAVE TO OBEY THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND COULD GIVE HIS STORY TO THE PRESS. PAISLEY, SR., STATED HE TOLD STEVENS HE WAS NOT UNDER ANY FBI ORDERS NOT TO TALK TO THE PRESS, AND THEN ANSWERED A FEW OF STEVENS' QUESTIONS. PAISLEY, SR., NOTED THAT STEVENS WAS TWISTING PAISLEY'S ANSWERS AND USING "LOADED" QUESTIONS, SUCH AS "HOW LONG DID YOU KNOW GALT

BEFORE YOU SOLD HIM THE MUSTANG"? PAISLEY THEN TERMINATED THIS INTERVIEW. AT ONE THIRTY A.M. TODAY PAISLEY RECEIVED LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE CALL FROM UNKNOWN REPORTER IN NEW YORK, BUT PAISLEY REFUSED TO ANSWER ANY OF HIS QUESTIONS. PAISLEY RECALLED TELLING LANKFORD HE COULD NOT IDENTIFY GALT FROM THE PHOTOS, BUT THIS WAS DONE TO PACIFY LANKFORD AND GET RID OF HIM. PAISLEY CONFIDENTIALLY ADVISED THAT BOTH HIS WIFE AND SON, WILLIAM DAVID PAISLEY, JR., HAVE BEEN UNDER DOCTOR'S CASE FOR NERVOUS CONDITIONS, AND HE WAS FEARFUL WHAT EFFECT THE HARASSMENT BY NEWS MEDIA WOULD HAVE ON THEM. BECAUSE OF THE RUDENESS AND INCONSIDERATION OF THE NEWS MEDIA, PAISLEY HAS RETREATED TO THE RESIDENCE OF HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW IN AN EFFORT TO AVOID THE NEWS MEDIA. HE IS MAINTAINING CONTACT WITH FBI, BIRMINGHAM, AS TO HIS WHEREABOUTS AND EXPRESSED HIS GRATITUDE FOR COURTEOUS MANNER IN WHICH THE FBI HAS DEALT WITH HIM, HIS SON, AND HIS WIFE.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT ON APRIL TWELVE, LAST, TWO REPORTERS CLAIMING TO BE FROM "THE LOS ANGELES TIMES" CONTACTED ROBERT WOOD, OWNER OF AEROMARINE SUPPLY COMPANY, BIRMINGHAM, AND HIS SON DONALD AND DEMANDED INFORMATION CONCERNING THE SALE OF THE RIFLE. WOOD LATER TOLD BUAGENT THAT BOTH MEN REEKED OF ALCOHOL AND

WERE APPARENTLY UNDER INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AT TIME. BOTH PRODUCED IDENTIFICATION AS BONA FIDE REPORTERS.

CHERPES ADVISED THAT HE HAS BEEN HARASSED CONTINUOUSLY BY TELEVISION AND NEWS MEDIA FOR INFORMATION CONCERNING GALT. CHERPES SAID THAT UNRECALLED NEWSPAPERMEN HAVE INQUIRED OF HIM IF THE FBI HAD PAID HIM NOT TO DIVULGE INFORMATION CONCERNING GALT OR IF THEY HAVE OFFERED HIM MONEY TO KEEP HIM QUIET. CHERPES SAID THAT HE HAS SET THE NEWS MEDIA STRAIGHT; THAT HE WOULD NEVER ACCEPT MONEY; AND THAT AT NO TIME HAS THE FBI EVER APPROACHED HIM OR MENTIONED MONEY.
