Examination of Q176 ("Arrew" map of Stlants) revealed the fellowing markings: In area number 7, ink lines were moted on Daniel Street between Arbor Avenue and Benievard Drive; in area number 03 an ink circle approximately 3/8 inch in diameter the center of which would be approximately on Auburn Avenue at Gartland; in area number 14, two link circle; which are approximately concentric with diameters of about 1/4 inch and 1/2 inch. The centers of these two circles lie approximately at the intersection of Simpson Road and Paines; in area number 09 an ink circle approximately 1/2 inch in diameter and the numeral 10 were noted. The center of this circle lies approximately on 14th Street between Crescent Avenue and Peachtree Road; in area number 06 as ink circle approximately 3/8 inch in diameter appears. The center of this circle is approximately at the meeting place of Highland View and Ponce de-Leon Terrace.

The notations setout below were observed on Q196 ("Atlantic Richfield Co." street map of Los Angeles.") On the top of that side of this map which costains the alphabetical street listings a small pencil circle was noted in the "Yan Buys Bistrict" at the intersection of Buffalo Avenue and Sanare Street.

On the large map on the other side of this map the following markings were noted in the Bevezly Hills area. Several brown to dark brown head bairs of Caucausan origin were found on the trousers and in the pocket debris. These hairs are different from the hairs from the Mustang and Semphis scene. It was concluded that they did not originate from the game source. We hairs were found on the Q201 peckin.

No fibers were found on the 9202 trousers or on the 9201 neektie that could be hespeiated with eleth items previously subsitted in this case.

No marks or labels were found on the 9201 necktis.

Examination of the other items described above disclosed no other pertinent information.

BLACKBURN stated that VAUGHN is to be in Norfolk with his brother-in-law at present, although he could furnish no address for either party and requested that the interviewing Agent attempt to obtain BLACKEURN'S release from the Maryland House of Correction, so that he could go to Norfolk and locate VAUGHN.

A review of BLACKBURN'S medical record at the Maryland House of Correction, Jessup, Maryland, reflected that a prison psychiatrist considered him as "emotionally unstable with a tendency to exaggerate on things which he has very little knowledge of".

CV 44-565 BOND advised that during this time of incarceration at Missouri State Penitentiary he was in K Hall, cell 187. He stated that the Missouri State Penitentiary has one-man cells and that JAMES EARL RAY, during this period of time, was incarcerated in cell 191. BOND stated that RAY was a bread man and that he worked in the bakery. He stated that RAY's duties consisted of slicing the bread for the meals and that because of these duties RAY would be up earlier than the other inmates and would usually be back in his cell at 7:00 AM and would be free to come and go as he pleased during meal hours. BOND advised that RAY was a racist and many times he heard him discussing his dislike for Negroes. BOND advised that he would be considered a friend of RAY's but this was due mainly to the fact that they both had free time and that their cells were near each others and that during break periods they would discuss various matters. BOND stated that RAY had no close friends inside the prison and would be considered strictly a loner. BOND stated that RAY was hooked on amphetamine powders. BOND stated that RAY always had an "outfit" in his cell, stating that an "outfit" was a nose dropped with a needle with which he would shoot a solution made up from the amphetamine powder into his veins. BOND stated that he considered RAY a "fiend" on amphetamine powders. He stated that he was constantly shooting the amphetamines into his veins. BOND stated that he was not sure exactly what type of amphetamines RAY used but that he knows that RAY secured the amphetamines through a source in the prison at a price that ranged anywhere from \$50 - \$100 per speenful.
