THIS ARTICLE STATED THAT THE HUNT FOR THE PERSON  
OR PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ASSASSINATION OF DR. KING NOW  
FOCUSES ON A "MYSTERIOUS HOLLYWOOD BLONDE AND A NEW ORLEANS  
INDUSTRIALIST." THE ARTICLE STATES THAT THE FBI LET IT BE  
KNOWN ON MONDAY "THAT THEY WERE IN SEARCH OF THE HOLLYWOOD  
BLONDE BUT COULD NOT LOCATE HER. THE REPORT WAS THAT SHE  
HAS DISAPPEARED."

THE ARTICLE STATES THAT LOMAX LOCATED THE BLONDE  
IN QUESTION LATE YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AND THAT SHE IS IN  
HER MID-TWENTIES AND AS SUSPECTED WAS A CLOSE CONFIDANT OF RAY.

FURTHER THAT THE BLONDE WAS A HABITUE OF THE SULTAN ROOM IN THE RABBIT'S FOOT BARS ALONG A SLEEZY SECTION OF HOLLYWOOD BLVD. THIS BLONDE USES SEVERAL NAMES ACCORDING TO LOMAX, BUT WAS KNOWN AS "JERRI."

THE ARTICLE ALLEGES THAT JERRI SPENT SEVERAL NIGHTS, PERHAPS WEEKS, WITH RAY AND THAT ON THE DAY RAY LEFT LOS ANGELES ON THE TRIP THAT LED HIM TO MEMPHIS, HE PURCHASED JERRI AN AIRPLANE TICKET TO A MID-WESTERN CITY WHERE SHE IS NOW VISITING WITH HER PARENTS.

LOMAX FURTHER ALLEGES IN THE ARTICLE THAT ON DECEMBER SIXTEEN, LAST, RAY WAS IN TELEPHONIC CONTACT WITH

A MAJOR NEW ORLEANS INDUSTRIALIST, A MAN WHO IS CONSIDERED THE ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL "KILLER" OF THE COMMUNITY.

FURTHER, THAT ON DECEMBER SEVENTEEN, LAST, RAY MET IN PERSON WITH THIS INDUSTRIALIST AND ON THE DAY OF THIS MEETING RAY WAS REGISTERED IN A MOTEL IN NEW ORLEANS. THE MEETING IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN "DOWNTOWN" NEW ORLEANS.

AND TELEPHONE NUMBER.

LOMAX DESCRIBED JERRI AS SPEAKING WITH A FOREIGN  
ACCENT AND IS PROBABLY FROM ONE OF THE SCANDINAVIAN  
COUNTRIES.

IN CONNECTION WITH INFORMATION APPEARING IN THIS  
ARTICLE, PRIOR INVESTIGATION BY NEW ORLEANS AT PROVINCIAL  
MOTEL, NEW ORLEANS, ESTABLISHED THAT JAMES EARL RAY  
REGISTERED AS ERIC S. GALT IN PROVINCIAL MOTEL ON DECEMBER  
SEVENTEEN, SIXTYSEVEN AND CHECKED OUT ON DECEMBER NINETEEN,  
SIXTYSEVEN. INVESTIGATION FURTHER ESTABLISHED NO PERTINENT<sup>E</sup>

IDENTITY OF THE ALLEGED UNKNOWN NEW ORLEANS INDUSTRIALIST REFERRED TO IN RE NEWS ARTICLE NOT KNOWN TO NEW ORLEANS OFFICE.

THE "RED FLASH" EDITION OF THE NEW ORLEANS STATES-ITEM INSTANT DATE CARRIES A REHASH OF REFERENCED ARTICLE AND, IN ADDITION, INCLUDES STATEMENT ATTRIBUTED TO NEW ORLEANS DISTRICT ATTORNEY, JIM GARRISON, WHICH IS QUOTED AS FOLLOWS:

"WE'RE VERY INTERESTED IN THE CASE."

HOWEVER, THE DA SAID, "WE HAVE NO DATA AT PRESENT. THE FEDERAL PEOPLE HAVE NOT GIVEN US THE INFORMATION."

REFERENCED NEWS ARTICLE BEING FORWARDED BUREAU, LOS ANGELES AND MEMPHIS AMSD INSTANT DATE.

FILES OF NEW ORLEANS DIVISION REVEAL THAT IN SUMMER OF SIXTYFIVE DURING RACIAL TURMOIL IN BOGALUSA, LA., AN INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFIED AS LOUIS LOMAX AND DESCRIBED AS A WRITER AND TELEVISION PERSONALITY FROM LOS ANGELES, CALIF., WAS PRESENT IN BOGALUSA ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS. DURING THESE OCCASIONS LOMAX MADE SPEECHES AND PARTICIPATED IN MARCHES CONDUCTED BY THE BOGALUSA VOTERS LEAGUE (BVL), A LOCAL CIVIL RIGHTS ORGANIZATION.

ON ONE OCCASION LOMAX IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS CHAIRMAN OF A GROUP KNOWN AS "CONCERNED CALIFORNIANS FOR BOGALUSA COMMITTEE." FILES REVEAL THAT ALLEGEDLY LOMAX HAD RAISED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS IN CALIFORNIA DURING SIXTYFIVE TO FURNISH TO THE BVL TO CONTINUE ITS OPERATIONS. HOWEVER, INFORMATION WAS FURNISHED BY A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE THAT OF THE ALLEGED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS RAISED BY LOMAX, ONLY APPROXIMATELY SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS HAD ACTUALLY BEEN FURNISHED BY LOMAX TO THE BVL.

ON APRIL EIGHTH, HE WAS IN OFFICE OF ROBERT ROULSTON, CITY MANAGER FOR AA, AT WASHINGTON, DC, WHO SHOWED HIM A CHECK FOR ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS FROM HENRY O'NEILL, CITY MANAGER FOR AA AT NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE, WHICH WAS PAYMENT OF BET THEY HAD MADE THAT DR. KING WOULD BE DEAD BY MAY FIRST, NINETEEN SIXTYEIGHT. ROULSTON INDICATED BET HAD BEEN MADE AT A DINNER ATTENDED BY OTHER AA OFFICIALS.

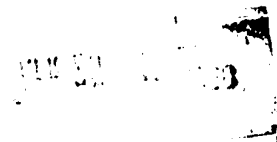

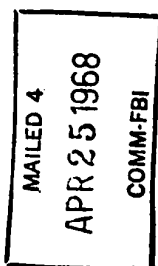
