1. DESPITE EXTENSIVE PUBLICITY IN INTERNATIONAL PRESS OF PRESENCE IN PORTUGAL FOR SOME DAYS IN MAY OF ALLEGED KILLER OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, THERE HAS STILL BEEN NO MENTION IN LOCAL PRESS OF THIS FACT.

2. NONETHELESS BY LAST WEEKEND INTERNATIONAL PRESS REPORTERS HERE HAD WIND OF PORTUGUESE ANGLE OF STORY AND HAD BEEN JOINED BY FAIRLY LARGE GROUP OF REPS FROM ENGLISH AND AMERICAN PRESS, MAGAZINES AND TV SEEKING DETAILS. INITIALLY THESE REPORTERS WERE FRUSTRATED BECAUSE OF DIFFICULTY TRACING RAY/SNEYD'S ACTIVITIES DURING HIS STAY AND INABILITY TO FIND ANY SOURCES OF HARD INFO. EVENTUALLY REPORTERS DUG OUT NAME OF LOCAL HOTEL WHERE RAY, UNDER NAME OF SNEYD, HAD BEEN STAYING AND INTERVIEWED HOTEL EMPLOYEES, GIRLS IN NEARBY BARS AND OTHER LOW LEVEL SOURCES WHO, WE GATHER, WERE UNABLE TO PROVIDE ANYTHING OTHER THAN LOCAL COLOR.

3. FOR DEPT'S INFO, WE BELIEVE REPORTERS, ESPECIALLY FROM LIFE, HAVE PURSUED TWO ANGLES HERE WHICH THEY MAY SEEK TO USE. FIRST OF THESE IS EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONNECTED WITH 1968 PORTUGAL/US EXTRADITION TREATY WHICH APPEARS TO FORECLOSE EXTRADITION TO US OF PERSON CHARGED WITH CAPITAL CRIME. WE UNDERSTAND REPORTERS MAY BE BUILDING ON THIS LIMITATION A SCENARIO BY WHICH AMERICAN AUTHORITIES, POSSIBLY INCLUDING EMBASSY, WERE AWARE OF RAY/SNEYD'S PRESENCE HERE BUT DID NOTHING ABOUT IT BECAUSE OF EXTRADITION TREATY PROVISIO, INSTEAD WAITING UNTIL HE WAS SOMEPLACE WHERE SUCH RESTRICTION DID NOT EXIST. ALTHOUGH EMBOFFS IN GOOD CONSCIENCE DENIED THEY HAD ANY KNOWLEDGE DURING DATES RAY/SNEYD WAS REPORTEDLY IN PORTUGAL OF HIS PRESENCE IN PORTUGAL, AND MADE NO COMMENT AFTER LEARNING OF FACTS FROM FBI REP, WE ARE NOT SURE THESE DENIALS HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED IN LIGHT OF "ANGLE" REPORTERS HAVE DISCOVERED.

4. OTHER ANGLE WAS THAT RAY/SNEYD CAME HERE TO INVESTIGATE POSSIBILITY OF ENLISTING AS MERCENARY GIVEN ALLEGED REPUTATION OF LISBON AS CENTER FOR MERCENARY RECRUITMENT. PURPOSE:

To recommend that the prosecutive summary report be disseminated to the Department, United States Attorney at Birmingham, and Phil M. Canale, State Attorney General, Shelby County, (Memphis) Tennessee.

BACKGROUND:

Reports were prepared by the field setting forth results of the investigation in this case and eight separate reports were disseminated to the United States Attorney at Birmingham and the Department. The reports were disseminated to the United States Attorney at Birmingham in view of the fact that the United States Attorney there authorized Federal prosecution. No copies of the reports were disseminated to the United States Attorney at Memphis. The reports that were disseminated contained, among numerous items, a listing of items of evidence recovered and the results of the FBI Laboratory examinations of such items. These reports, as well as the prosecutive summary report, contain no information of a confidential nature and have been prepared suitable for dissemination.

On May 7, 1968, an indictment charging subject James Earl Ray with murder, was returned by the authorities in Shelby County, Tennessee. In light of this and due to the fact that they will no doubt prosecute Ray on charges of murder, a copy of our prosecutive summary report as prepared by Memphis should be transmitted to Mr. Phil M. Canale, State Attorney General, Shelby County, Tennessee, who will be handling the State prosecution. When copies of this report are disseminated, the receiving persons will be issued instructions that the report or the contents thereof should not be disclosed outside the receiving agencies, except for prosecutive purposes.

On 6/18/68, DELBERT HEEDERIK, Laboratory Aide, Radio Isotope Section, Wood Veterans Hospital, Wood, Wisconsin, furnished the following information concerning instant case:

HEEDERIK, a recovered alcoholic, with a record of numerous arrests for drunkenness and disorderly conduct by the Milwaukee Police Department, advised that approximately 5/27/67, he was staying at the Holders Hotel in Gulfport, Mississippi. He stated that he occupied an upstairs front room on the southeast corner of the Hotel, and that the room directly west of him was occupied by an individual he described as a muscle man for the Klan. He also stated that an individual known to him as RICH (LNU) occupied the room west of the Klansman's room. He stated that while staying at the Hotel, he was employed at Oberlies Radio and TV Company as a repair technician.

HEEDERIK stated that on approximately 5/27/67, he invited a man known to him only as RICH (LNU), and who was reportedly to be a guitar player, into his room for a glass of beer. He stated that while he and RICH were drinking beer, they noticed a large black automobile, which appeared to be an executive limousine, drive up in

Scotland Yard is continuing intensive investigation to account for the subject's whereabouts in London between May 17 and 28, 1968. It is noted that at the time of his arrest his only identification papers were in the name of RAMON GEORGE SNEYD and his Canadian passport does not show any exit from England after his arrival 5/17/68. To have left England he would have needed a passport and the passport would have been stamped at the time of his departure, and again at the time of his return, as well as at the time of his arrival and departure from any other country he visited.

Chief Inspector KENNETH THOMPSON, Scotland Yard, has advised in confidence that he interviewed Major ALISTAIR WICKS. WICKS has been a leader in mercenary forces for a number of years and is considered to be an established liaison man and go-between for the hiring of mercenaries. WICKS stated that he had reason to believe RAY had contacted the Biafra Mission in Lisbon and made application to go to Biafra as a mercenary, but that Biafra does not want any outsiders to enter the country at this time.

The transistor radio in subject's possession at the time of his arrest is labeled on the outside "Deluxe Hi Fi" and "Merc-Radio." On the inside of the plastic cover which removes to provide access to the batteries, there is attached a paper bearing a schematic diagram of the set, and on this paper are two stamped numbers, "Model HT-6043" and Model HT-6082." No other pertinent information could be found on the outside ~~of~~ inside of the radio. The radio was equipped with an Ever-Ready 9 volt battery, Model PP3.

As the Bureau has been advised, ads have been placed in London newspapers on behalf of the Washington Post to solicit information from the public regarding RAY's activities between May 17 and 28, 1968. Scotland Yard had previously considered a public appeal for such information and attempted to arrange such publicity on 6/18/68, but permission was denied by the Home Office.

Scotland Yard has done a tremendous amount of work in attempting to completely trace RAY's movements and is continuing to expend a great deal of manpower. This is being closely followed with the Yard and the Bureau will be kept currently advised of pertinent developments.
