At 12:50 AM today ROBERT MULLIN and MICKEY BUSBY, students at Memphis State University, residence 331 McCord Hall, phone Memphis 321-2349, advised the following information:

Today while hitch-hiking to Knoxville from Memphis they were picked up at Brownsville, Tenn. at about 6:00 PM by an individual who gave his name as BUD MITCHELL, age 25 to 30, six ft., dark brown hair, short normal cut, 145 to 150 lbs., well dressed, medium build, driving pale yellow mustang automobile, bearing Maryland license GJ7883

MITCHELL told complainants that he had been to Memphis and was returning Washington, D.C. Said lived in Maryland where had wife whom he had run out on about two months ago. Said that he was an ex-government employee, believed to be some type investigative agency.

MITCHELL stated that he had gone to Memphis "to see King march at an earlier date but King chickened out because of the snow." Said that he had pistol under dash of car and that he owned a rifle. MITCHELL allegedly told complainants that "things will quieten down after they bury that creep" and also said that "the president will probably be next." It has been determined that a rifle abandoned near the scene of the crime was purchased in Birmingham, Alabama, 3/30/68, by an individual using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. The same individual had purchased a rifle in Birmingham on 3/29/68 and this rifle was traded in on the one purchased 3/30/68. LOWMEYER or LOWMYER is generally described as white male, 36 years old, 5'8" tall, 150 to 160 pounds, black or dark brown hair.

In view of the unusual nature of the names LOWMEYER and LOWMYER, immediately check all city directories, voter registration records, and credit and criminal records on the surnames LOWMEYER and LOWMYER.
