

Remember, the fellow in the BEEF BOX also had a "scar center of fore-head". He and his sister pointed out that fact, and it was shown up by the cameras.

Just want to help out, if at all possible, this man who claims he is innocent and a victim of mistaken identity.

The following investigation was conducted by IC WILLIAM C. MC DONALD at Jefferson City, Missouri:

On May 1, 1968, Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) records were checked for RAY EUGENE WARREN. The following information was obtained:

RAY EUGENE WARREN was received at the MSP on June 9, 1955, to serve a 10 year sentence on charge of robbery first degree by means of a dangerous and deadly weapon under court case #1941-C. He completed this sentence and began an additional 20 year sentence on July 11, 1961, on charge of robbery first degree by means of a dangerous and deadly weapon, court case number 1945-C. He was assigned MSP number 69963. WARREN was discharged by commutation of sentence from April 13, 1968. Relatives listed on WARREN's correspondence and visiting list are wife DORIS WARREN, 3330 Sims, St. Anne, Missouri; brother-in-law BILL SCOTT, same address; sister, BETTY WARREN, Route 2, Box 187, Robertson, Missouri. Records reflect that WARREN was visited by his mother and brother, PAUL WARREN, Robertson, Missouri, and brother, SCOTT WARREN, Pomona, California. While WARREN was in the MSP, he was in the following cells:

From November 6, 1959, until January 4, 1960, G70; From January 4, 1960, until July 1, 1960, G89; From Jly 1, 1960, until August 31, 1960, C20; From August 31, 1960, until October 31, 1960, E80; October 31, 1960, until January 6, 1961, E33; January 6, 1961, until March 17, 1961, F96.

Warden HAROLD SWENSON advised confidentially that warren had assisted his department in an investigation which had been conducted and that from November, 1965, until after JAMES EARL RAY escaped from the MSP, that WARREN was in solitary confinement being given maximum security for fear of his life. Warden SWENSON continued that if at all possible, WARREN should not be contacted as he is extremely nervous and fearful for his life. However, Warden SWENSON advised that WARREN is to be living with his brother, SCOTT L. WARREN at 17902 Edmond Place, Covina, California.

SINCE WARREN WAS SENTENCED TO THE MSP FOR A TOTAL PERIOD OF 30 YEARS ON CHARGE OF ROBBERY WITH A DANGEROUS AND DEADLY WEAPON AND IS EXTREMELY NERVOUS, HE SHOULD BE APPROACHED WITH CAUTION AND POSSIBLY CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.

DORIS DEAN JONES was interviewed at San Diego, and advised she formerly knew a RAY EUGENE WARREN, who would now be 38 years of age, white male, 5' 8", 150 lbs., dark brown wavy hair, blue eyes; numerous tattoos - rose on back of one hand, RAY on one hand, LOVE on fingers of one hand, and a "Pachuco" type cross on one hand.

Mrs. JONES advised RAY EUGENE WARREN, during 1955, was incarcerated at St. Louis City Jail for period of one year prior to being sentenced to 30 years at the State Prison, Jefferson City, Missouri. At 4:05 am, 5-4-68, WALKER C. PLOUNT, who identified himself as a security officer at the International Hotel, LA International Airport, (telephone 670-9000, Ext. 597), called to say that one of the drivers at the hotel, one ANDREW TAYLOR, JR., DELICHMENT SAW a man in the hotel lobby whom he believes to bear a strong resemblance to JAMES EARL RAY.

ANDREW TAXLOR, JR., 1149 W. 106th St., LA, a driver for the International Hotel, advised that about 3:30 am he was on his way to the mens room when he observed a man obtaining a pack of cigarettes from the cigarette machine. When this man saw him approaching, he gave a start, became nervous in manner, and quickly walked away, in the direction of the hotel elevators. He, TAYLOR, proceeded to the men's room and, upon returning to the lobby a few moments later, did not see the man, leading him to believe the man had returned to his room. He recalled having seen newspaper photos of JAMES MARL RAY and his impression was that this man closely resembles RAY. He feels certain that the man is staying at the hotel, as he was not seen to enter the hotel from the outside and proceed to the cigarette machine; he appeared to have come down to t he lobby via the elevator, got his cigarettes, and then returned to his room. However, he is not certain of this, as he did not see the man get into an elevator after obtaining the cigarettes.

Following ************************ the above, he went to the ***necurity officer, located in the timekeeper's office, and viewed the photos of RAY on the FBI Wanted Flyer. This supported his belief the man he saw in the lobby could be RAY, or at least bore a strong resemblance to him, especially the 1960 photos.

He advised that during this parole, he had lived for several weeks at the Poinsetta Gardens Motel in Gardena.

The following investigation was conducted by SAL. HOYT MC GUIRE on 4/15/68 having been instituted on the above referred to complaint memo.

Mrs. DOROTHY GRACE, Manager, Poinsetta Gardens Motel, 13921 South Normandie, Gardena, California, telephone DAvis 4-5883, made available motel registration card number 1418 in the name of HAL BILLS, 13535 (street not shown), Gardena, California, which indicated that BILLS had checked into this hotel on May 31, 1967, and had checked out on July 8, 1967. The registration card indicated that BILLS had given an address to notify in case of emergency as 13525 Vermont, Gardena, California, telephone 327-0857.

Mrs. GRACE had originally furnished information concerning a JOHN WIDNARD, who had been registered at this hotel, and expressed the opinion that the artist's conception of ERIC STARVO GALT bore a resemblance to HAL BILLS. Mrs. GRACE recalled that BILLS had stayed at this motel alone and, in fact was generally always alone, and never appeared to have any company. She said that he did work, although he kept saying he was desperate for a job. She said that one day he complained that he was not feeling well and had to walk some place. She said she felt sorry for him and wanted to lend him her car, but he said he had no license. She recalls that BILLS always kept to himself during the day time, but would occasionally go out at night. She said he liked Western music and had a guitar and phonograph with alot of records. She said he drank Vodka and appeared to be skilled in lathe work. Mrs. GRACE recalled also that one day when BILLS became suddenly very ill and asked for help, he declined to permit her to call a doctor and got rather upset when she told him she was going to call the police.

She said he explained his illness by indicating he had gotten drunk the night before and had been in a fight and was ashamed and did not want anyone to know. recalled that on this occasion that BILLS had asked her to call a girl firned which Mrs. GRACE remembered was a San Pedro telephone number, bur she said when she talked to this girl on the telephone the girl refused to have anything to do with BILLS and stated he was no good and not to bother her again. Mrs. GRACE further said that the girl friend had commented BILLS was a "lunatic," and she did not want to get mixed up with him. Mrs. GRACE said that she finally did call a doctor whose phone number was given to her by BILLS, and she said that BILLS presumably went to visit the doctor by taxi cab and had his ribs taped. She said that the day following this incident BILLS checked out after thanking her for being so good to him, and he at this time gave her a little gift of a Redwood Pen stand.

Mrs. GRACE recalled that BILLS always paid his rent in cash, which to her was rather amazing since he never seemed to work. She said she recalled BILLS remarking he had been in the Merchant Marines. She said he had a tattoo of a flower on his lower right arm, which he explained he had gotten while in the Merchant Marines.

Mrs. GRACE described BILLS as follows:

Mrs. GRACE also recalled that while he was at the hotel and while he had been ill, a phone call had been placed to his mother who apparently lived a short distance from the motel and who visited BILLS for only a few minutes. Mrs. GRACE, upon viewing the IO photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT as depicted in wanted flier number 442, said that this photograph resembled HAL BILLS. Mrs. GRACE recalled that HAL BILLS had had a telephone installed in his room when he lived at this address.

Mrs. EMMA CUMMINGS, 14021 South Budlong, Gardena, California, telephone 329-7914, on 4/19/68 informed that when she had viewed the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT on television, she had remarked to her husband that she had seen this individual at the hotel where she works. Mrs. CUMMINGS said that when Mrs. GRACE later mentioned room 129 to her, she immediately recalled that the HAL BILLS, who lived in room 129 strongly resembled ERIC STARVO GALT.
