On April 8, 1968, the Headquarters of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D. C., advised that information had been received by a secretary in the Attorney General's Office had received a telephone call at 5:30 P. M. that date from an individual who identified himself as FREDRICK DUNSTON, White field, North Carolina, Route 350, who was calling the Attorney General to report that a white man was at his residence, drunk with a gun, who had said he was the person who killed MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

The following investigation was conducted by SA DAVID W. WATSON:

AT WHITEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

On the night of April 8, 1968, Chief of Police WADE WHITE, Whiteville Police Department; and HORACE SHAW, Superintendent, Columbus County Bureau of Identification, Whiteville, advised they could locate no record of FREDRICK DUNSTON: They advised that there is no Route 350 in that area.

On April 9, 1968, FREDRICK LEON DUNSTON was located on Route 5, Box 150, Whiteville, North Carolina, at which time he advised that he is employed as a long shoreman at Wilmington, North Carolina, and Sunny Point, North Carolina. He advised he previously served three years in the North Carolina Prison Department on charges of receiving stolen property.

DUNSTON stated he had been drinking on April 8, 1968, and did not report for work. Late in the afternoon on that date, while sitting on his porch, an unknown individual described as a white male, twenty-three to twenty-five years of age, blue eyes, black hair, five feet ten inches, medium build, dark complexion, with a tattoo of a heart with the words "Born to Lose," on his upper right arm, walked by his residence. The individual was wearing blue dungarees with white, short sleeve, sport shirt with yellow vertical stripes. In conversation with the individual, he told DUNSTON that he was in bad trouble and asked DUNSTON if he knew Dr. KING. He told DUNSTON that he was the individual who shot Dr. KING. The unknown man stated he needed two dollars and DUNSTON advised he gave the man three dollars and fifty cents. DUNSTON stated the man remained at his residence until after midnight but he does not know in which direction he went when he departed. The man did not identify himself or say where he was from. DUNSTON advised that this unknown man was extremely scared and appeared to be intelligent and talked in an intelligent manner.

The first bus from Whiteville, North Carolina, departed at 11:40 A. M., and it was observed that an individual fitting this description was not on that bus.

The following investigation was conducted by SA HOWARD C. BURGIN:

WHITEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 9, 1968, Patrolman RALPH SPAULDING, Whiteville, North Carolina, Police Department, advised at 7:30 P. M. on that date he arrested FREDRICK DUNSTON and placed him in the Columbus County Jail, Whiteville, North Carolina. He was charged with possession of non-tax paid whisky and public drunk. Officer SPAULDING stated he has arrested DUNSTON on numerous occasions for public drunk and disorderly conduct. He stated DUNSTON has a reputation for being a drunk and stated it is doubtful any information DUNSTON furnishes would be reliable.

On April 10, 1968, FREDRICK DUNSTON was interviewed at the Columbus County Jail, at which time he advised that about 7 P. M. on April 9, 1968, he observed the unknown white male who had admitted killing MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., riding in a 1962 Ford Galaxie, beige in color, occupied by two other persons. The car was seen near Smith's Restaurant on 701 Bypass, Whiteville, traveling in a southerly direction.

DUNSTON advised that HENRY BENNETT was with him at the time he observed the car and he commented that a friend of his was in the car.

He stated shortly thereafter, he was arrested by the Whiteville Police and placed in jail. He said he attempted to call the Attorney General in Washington and advise him of the information but he was unable to complete the call. MP 44-1987 CE 44-1635 CFW:lrf

DUNSTON viewed the artist's sketch of KING's assassin and advised that the photograph appeared similar to the unknown man who admitted killing KING; however, he said he would be unable to recognize this man from the sketch.

On April 10, 1968, DENNIS WILLIAMS, Jailer, Columbus County, North Carolina, Jail, Whiteville, North Carolina, advised that at about 7:30 P. M., April 9, 1868, FREDRICK DUNSTON was placed in jail and attempted to make a telephone call to the Attorney General in Washington, and he also attempted to make a telephone call to Raleigh, North Carolina; however, he was in such a drunken condition, he was unable to complete the calls.

On April 10, 1968, SARAH MOORE, Route 5, Box 150, Whiteville, North Carolina, advised that DUNSTON and his wife and two children rent a room in her house. She said that DUNSTON has a reputation for drinking and for being arrested for public drunk. She stated she was at her residence on April 8, 1968, when DUNSTON allegedly was contacted by an unknown white male and she stated that she was not aware of anyone being at her residence and does not believe that there was anybody at her residence as she would have known. She stated that DUNSTON is unreliable and does not believe that any information obtained from him would be of value or reliable.

On April 10, 1968, JOHN W. BENNETT, Funeral Director, Peoples Funeral Home, Whiteville, advised that FREDRICK DUNSTON and his brother, HENRY BENNETT, are both alcoholics and have been drinking heavily for the past four or five days. He stated that any information received from DUNSTON or his brother, HENRY, would not be truthful as both have been drinking and are unreliable.

On April 10, 1968, members of the Whiteville Police Department, who were alerted concerning the unknown white male, advised they have not observed anyone fitting the description of this man in the vicinity of Whiteville. They advised they are not familiar with a 1962 beige Ford Galaxie and have not seen any car fitting this description in the area.

The following investigation was conducted by IC MARION E. HILLIARD:

AT RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 10, 1968, Mrs. MARTHA UPCHURCH, Records Section, North Carolina Department of Corrections, Raleigh, North Carolina, advised the records reflect that FREDDIE LEON DUNSTON was received at the Prison Department on June 5, 1959, to serve from three to five years for receiving and possession of stolen property and to serve eighteen to twenty-four months for unlawful entry. He was paroled July 3, 1962, and his parole was revoked December 10, 1962, after he was found guilty of indecent exposure. He was discharged from the North Carolina Department of Corrections on July 13, 1963, and was agains received on July 15, 1966, to serve a one month sentence for public drunkeness.

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A report in the Department of Corrections files by J. F. OWEN, psychiatrist, revealed that DUNSTON was diagnosed as adult situational reaction -provisional. This report revealed DUNSTON received an injury in an automobile accident in 1958. Since that time, his mother had noted a definite change in his reaction and definite change in his attitude toward community affairs. His own family relationship became frought with irritations and certain difficulties.

The files also revealed that during an interview with a prison official on June 10, 1959, the official noted, "DUNSTON extremely suave and smooth-talking individual, who boasts of his social activities and accomplishments in life. DUNSTON stated he is not guilty of charge that he is serving time for and knows nothing about the crime."

The following investigation was conducted by IC RALPH D. HILL:

AT CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 10, 1968, Mr. WILLIAM CLYDE MILLSAPS, 926 Howard Avenue, Gastonia, North Carolina, advised that he would like to furnish the following information to the FBI on a confidential basis:

He stated that he has a nephew by the name of JOHN CLINTON MILLSAPS, white male, age twenty, six feet one inch to six feet two inches, two hundred twenty pounds, blond hair, dresses well, who resides in Salt Lake City, Utah, telephone number 1-801-359-4897, which is an unlisted number. He stated the boy was discharged from the Army in the summer of 1967, and that the boy inherited a considerable amount of money from his father and is now wealthy.

Mr. MILLSAPS stated that in January or February, 1968, the boy and his wife visited him for approximately three days. He stated that during this visit, the boy advised him that he was going to purchase a high-powered rifle to shoot Negroes with. He stated he advised the boy at that time not to get involved in any type of violence. He stated the boy did not indicate that he was a member of any type of organization during his conversation regarding the purchase of the rifle. Mr. MILLSAPS stated the boy is reportedly a "crack-shot" with a rifle.

Mr. MILLSAPS stated he did not hear from his nephew again until approximately one week prior to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated he received a telephone call from the boy from Richmond, Virginia. He advised the boy told him he was working for a sign company but did not mention the name of the company. He stated that the boy advised him he was coming to visit him for about three days and then would go on to Atlanta, Goergia. He stated that during the telephone conversation he asked the boy why he was working as a traveling salesman but the boy did not say. He stated he tolephe large that he did not have to do that type of work due tolephe large inheritance he had received. Mr. MILLSAPS stated the ploy did not come to his home as he said he would. Therefore he had received the boy's residence in Salt Lake City and talked with the

wife, who advised him that his nephew was not at home due to his employment with a machine company, name of company not mentioned. Mr. MILLSAPS thought it was strange that the boy advised him he was working for a sign company and the boy's wife advised he was employed by a machine company. He stated he requested the boy's wife have him call, but has not heard from the boy yet.

Mr. MILLSAPS stated that after MARTIN LUTHER KING was killed, a composite drawing of the subject responsible was published in the newspaper. He stated that viewing the picture, he feels his nephew strongly resembles the individual. Mr. MILLSAPS stated he is afraid that the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING could possibly be his nephew due to the resemblance of the boy with the picture in the paper and the fact that the boy had stated that he was going to purchase a high-powered rifle to use on Negores. He stated he had no other reason to suspect his nephew other than the reasons mentioned above.

Mr. MILLSAPS statedhhe does not know what kind of automobile his nephew drives but at one time had a Cadillac and later purchased a new Chevrolet. He stated he feels the boy is not driving around the country in connection with his employment but feels he is flying on commercial airlines because the boy stated during the telephone call mentioned above that he would call him from the Charlotte Airport when he arrived.

Mr. MILLSAPS advised that his nephew's address is 87 West South North Street, Salt Lake City, Utah. He advised he does not have a photograph of his nephew.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

April 10, 1968

A review of the Army service record for DONNIE LEON HARDEN, Army Serial Number RA24553268, on file at the Military Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, disclosed that HARDEN served in the U.S. Army on active duty from May 1, 1958 at Montgomery, Alabama, to honorable discharge from active duty and transferred to the Reserve at Oakland, California, March 31, 1961. He thereafter entered on active duty in the Army at Montgomery, Alabama on May 22, 1963, and served until honorable discharge due to hardship at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, June 4, 1965. Rank at time of discharge was Specialist Fourth Grade. He also had inactive service in the Alabama National Guard, April 21, 1955 to April 30, 1958, and May 15, 1962 to December 17, 1962. He served in the inactive U.S. Army Reserve from April 1, 1961 to April 30, 1962. His military occupation was listed as Communications Center Specialist. His civilian occupation was listed as Welder, Farmer and Musician (singing and guitar). The file failed to show any courts-martial or absences without official leave but did indicate a reduction in rank in December, 1962, while in the National Guard due to inefficiency. No details appear.

Top secret clearance was granted him on September 30, 1958, based on a background investigation completed September 24, 1958 by the Army Security Agency, Third Army Area, Dossier Number H3008562.

Throughout his service his home address is listed as Route C, Evergreen, Alabama. In 1963, an address of 6125 Ridgement Avenue, Houston, Texas appeared and his address at the time of final discharge was listed as 701 Roxella, Houston, Texas.

He has blood group "O". He received an expert's badge in the MI carbine. He had foreign service of one year, eight months, and 15 days in the Pacific Theater.

A letter from his wife appeared in the file dated April 2, 1965, addressed to Lieutenant General J. L. RICHARDSON, Fort Houston, Texas, which alleged that HARDEN had made false statements in applying for a hardship discharge. She stated HARDEN had indicated he was going to run his father's firm in Evergreen, Alabama, and that she was a nervous wreck worrying about him going overseas, all of which was untrue. She stated that he had a job waiting for him at Brown and Root Construction Company as a heavy equipment operator. She further stated that he had been a different man since his service in Okinawa as he had beaten her several times and had spent one night in jail on arrest by the Alamo Heights Police Department in San Antonio, Texas for having beaten her. She stated his temper and filthy language were terrible. She stated she had tried to leave him but had been told by him he would kill her and all three of their children if she She stated he purchased a rifle and cartridges the following day. She stated he had torn up several pieces of their furniture, half of her clothing, broken her watch, and had choked her on several occasions. She further alleged mistreatment of their 15 month old son.

The file further reflected a statement by HARDEN that his wife had previously suffered a complete nervous

breakdown and that she apparently was approaching a similar breakdown at the time of his discharge.




