RE: SUSPECT - WILLIAM GARY SHAVER

The following investigation was conducted on April 15, 1968, at Beaufort, South Carolina, by SA DANIEL F. O'SULLIVAN:

Staff Sergeant LARRY WARREN, Marine Serial Number [REDACTED] Marine Corps Air Station, residence 1343 Cardinal Lane, Laurel Bay, South Carolina, advised that he saw an individual in Beaufort, South Carolina, who resembled the composite sketch of someone who was allegedly connected with the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. Staff Sergeant WARREN advised that he was walking on Carteret Street in Beaufort, South Carolina, on Saturday, April 13, 1968, and passed a house located at 906 Carteret Street. He said that on the front porch of this house he observed a man sitting on the porch reading a newspaper and that this individual reminded him of a sketch he saw on a national news television show sometime during the prior week. WARREN said he could not recall the name of the individual whose sketch appeared on television, but recalled that this was the individual seen leaving a boarding house located in the area where Dr. KING was killed.

Staff Sergeant WARREN described the individual he saw sitting on the porch as follows:

A review of the 1966-1967 Beaufort City Directory showed that the house located at 906 Carteret Street, was a boarding house operated by Mrs. JANIE YOUNG.

Mrs. JANIE YOUNG, Youngs Boarding House, 906 Carteret Street, advised that on Saturday, April 13, 1968, she had two boarders staying at her boarding house. She said that she did not remember either one of her boarders sitting on the front porch reading a newspaper at any time on the previous Saturday, but noted that one of her boarders, a Mr. LINBERG, is an old man and seldom leaves his room. Mrs. YOUNG said her second boarder was WILLIAM SHAVER, who moved into her boarding house on April 3, 1968. Mrs. YOUNG said that SHAVER has stayed at her boarding house on several occasions and she has learned that SHAVER is from Greenville, South Carolina.

Mrs. YOUNG stated that SHAVER called her on Wednesday, April 3, 1968, and said that he was coming to Beaufort that day and would like to stay at her boarding house. SHAVER moved in that evening and has resided there ever since.

Mrs. YOUNG further advised that SHAVER is employed as a painter with the Coastal Cabinet Company, Beaufort, South Carolina. She described him as a white male, in mid forties, short in stature, medium build, dark wavy hair and fair complexion.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JULIAN P. DOWLING at Beaufort, South Carolina, on April 15, 1968:

Mr. WILLIAM KEARSE, Coastal Cabinet Works, 702 Bladen Street, advised that WILLIAM G. SHAVER, Greenville, South Carolina, Social Security Number - [REDACTED], started work as a painter at the Coastal Cabinet Works on April 8, 1968.

WILLIAM GARY SHAVER, Youmans Boarding House,

said that he left Greenville, South Carolina, by Greyhound
Bus on April 3, 1968, and arrived in Beaufort, South
Carolina, at 9 p.m. that evening. He moved into Youmans
Boarding House that evening and remained there until
the morning of April 8, 1968, when he reported to work
at the Coastal Cabinet Works, Beaufort, South Carolina.
SHAVER stated that he never left Beaufort, South Carolina,
for any reason during the period April 3-8, 1968.

YOUNANS was recontacted at which time she advised that
SHAVER had in fact been at her boarding house from April 3
through April 15, 1968. Mrs. YOUNANS stated that, with
the exception of the past two days, when SHAVER has been
working, he never left her boarding house for any great
length of time.

On 4/15/68, Mrs. SADIE REID, a waitress at the Watstull Restaurant and Motel on Interstate 81 at Arcadia, Va., advised on 4/15/68, that at about 9:00 A.M., 4/11/68, a young white man came into the restaurant and ate breakfast. While he was there, he purchased two post cards and when he left asked if she could mail the cards for him. She agreed to mail the cards and after he left, she read them and noted the contents and the way that they were signed and decided to turn them over to the FBI rather than mail them.

Mrs. REID furnished the cards which read as follows:

"George,

"Should you ever again warn me about Houston's rain, you'll be speaking to a confirmed believer. Visability was so poor, could only do 40MPH. Having neither radar nor pontoons, stayed over at Winnie, Tex (25 mi W. of Beaumont)

"Had rain all thru Louisiana, too, but from Alabama on its been beautiful.

The box was labeled "Mauser". One of the stewardesses aboard the flight stored the box in the cockpit until the termination of the flight. The above mentioned flight departed Washington National Airport at 8:09 A.M., and arrived at Atlanta at 9:43 A.M. The man carrying the box was described as approximately 5'11", stocky, and wearing sunglasses.

At approximately 12:30 a.m., 4/19/68, Mrs. AVA SUDDUTH, 1088 College, telephonically advised that she wanted to bring two 14-year-old boys into the FBI Office as they had information of value she felt concerning captioned matter.

On 4/19/68 at approximately 1:00 a.m., Mrs. SUDDUTH appeared at the Memphis Office with MARVIN SUDDUTH, 1088 College, and REGINALD COMAN, 1392 Chadwick Circle, both Negro males, age 14.

These two individuals advised that on Monday afternoon, 4/15/68, at approximately 2:30 p.m., they were in Riverside Park, Memphis, Tennessee, near the boat loading ramp for McKellar Lake, with a companion, same age, ANTHONY WRIGHT, who lives at an unknown address on Chadwick Circle. At this time WRIGHT's bicycle broke down and they were attempting to fix it. When this was going on, a man came up and asked them where a refreshment bar was located in the park. After they gave this man directions to the nearest refreshment stand, they engaged him in conversation. He advised that he had just gotten out of the Army and that he had been stationed in West Germany at Berlin. He further advised that he was just bumming around and was looking also for a place to go fishing. He also advised that he was not staying any place in particular. When they asked him how he was going to eat, he advised that he had a knife and he could catch wild game in the woods and clean it and eat it with this knife. He also had with him a white paper sack and from it he displayed pictures of the President and Vice President of the United States and also various pieces of Army literature concerning recruitment. He also had some magazines in this sack.

SUDDUTH advised that he saw the picture of GALT in the morning papers on 4/18/68, and at that time
