## RE: SUSPECT - WILLIAM GARY SHAVER

The following investigation was conducted on April 15, 1968, at Beaufort, South Carolina, by SA DANIEL F. O'SULLIVAN:

Staff Sergeant LARRY WARREN, Marine Serial Number Marine Corps Air Station, residence 1343 Cardinal Lane, Laurel Bay, South Carolina, advised that he saw an individual in Beaufort, South Carolina, who resembled the composite sketch of someone who was allegedly connected with the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. Staff Sergeant WARREN advised that he was walking on Carteret Street in Beaufort, South Carolina, on Saturday, April 13, 1968, and passed a house located at 906 Carteret He said that on the front porch of this house he observed a man sitting on the porch reading a newspaper and that this individual reminded him of a sketch he saw on a national news television show sometime during the prior week. WARREN said he could not recall the name of the individual whose sketh appeared on television, but recalled that this was the individual seen leaving a boarding house located in the area where Dr. KING was killed.

Staff Sergeant WARREN described the individual he saw sitting on the porch as follows:

Mrs. JANIE YOUMANS, Youmans Boarding House, 906 Carteret Street, advised that on Saturday, April 13, 1968, she had two boarders staying at her boarding house. She said that she did not remember dither one of her boarders sitting on the front porch reading a newspaper at any time on the previous Saturday, but noted that one of her boarders, a Mr. LINBERG, is an old man and seldom leaves his room. Mrs. YOUMANS said her second boarder was WILLIAM SHAVER, who moved into her boarding house on April 3, 1968. Mrs. YOUMANS said that SHAVER has stayed at her boarding house on several occasions and she has learned that SHAVER is frem@Greenville, South Carolina.

Mrs. YOUMANS stated that SHAVER called her on Wednesday, April 3, 1968, and said that he was coming to Beaufort that day and would like to stay at her boarding house. SHAVER moved in that evening and has resided there ever since.

Mrs. YOUMANS further advised that SHAVER is employed as a painter with the Coastal Cabinet Company, Beaufort, South Carolina. She described him as a white male, in mid forties, short in statute, medium build, Bark wavy hair and fair complexion.

SHAVER stated that he never left Beaufort, South Carolina, for any reason during the period April 3-8, 1968.

At approximately 12:30 a.m., 4/19/68, Mrs. AVA SUDDUTH, 1088 College, telephonically advised that she wanted to bring two 14-year-old boys into the FBI Office as they had information of value she felt concerning captioned matter.

On 4/19/68 at approximately 1:00 a.m., Mrs. SUDDUTH appeared at the Memphis Office with MARVIN SUDDUTH, 1988 College, and REGINALD COMMAN, 1392 Chadwick Circle, both Negro males, age 14,

These two individuals advised that on Monday afternoon, 4/15/68, at approximately 2:30 p.m., they were in Riverside Park, Memphis, Tennessee, near the boat loading ramp for McKellar Lake, with a companion, same age, ANTHONY WRIGHT, who lives at an unknown address on Chadwick Circle. At this time WRIGHT's bicycle broke down and they were attempting to fix it. When this was going on, a man came up and asked them where a refreshment bar was located in the park. After they gave this man directions to the nearest refreshment stand, they engaged him in conversation. He advised that he had just gotten out of the Army and that he had been stationed in West Germany at Berlin. He further advised that he was just bumming around and was looking also for a place to go fishing. He also advised that he was not staying any place in particular. When they asked him how he was going to eat, he advised that he had a knife and he could catch wild game in the woods and clean it and eat it with this knife. He also had with him a white paper sack and from it he displayed pictures of the President and Vice President of the Umited States and also various pieces of Army literature concerning recruitment. He also had some magazines in this sack. 44-1987- Sub-6-56

SUDDUTH advised that he saw the picture of GALT in the morning papers on 4/18/68, and at that time

thought it looked like the man he and his companion had seen in the park but said nothing about it. COHRAN advised that he did not see the picture of GALT until the evening of 4/18/68, and at that time contacted MARVIN and they agreed the man they saw in the picture was very similar to the man they had seen in the park.

They both advised that after the conversation with this man ended, he just walked off in a southerly direction. They observed no mode of transportation connected with this man. They described this individual they observed in Riverside Park as follows:
