AT OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON , N. AC

On July 80, 1968, FRED DERRICK, Chief of Police, Olympia, advised he knows of no person by the name of GERRY BARNETT.

A check of telephone number 943-7928, disclosed it was registered to JIM J. FRUNZ, 3133 South Lorne, Olympia, and that he is the local sales manager for Smith Corona Business Machines. Efforts to locate FRUNZ at place of employment and residence disclosed that he had disappeared last week end with his secretary and that his wife had left him and returned to hereparents' home in Seattle, Washington, telephone ME 2-1145.

On July 31, 1968, FRUNZ called the Olympia Resident Agency in response to a stop left with his place of business. He admitted making the phone call to the Shelby County, Tennessee Sheriff's Office on July 20, 1968. He said he had been drinking all evening and arguing with his wife. He noticed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY being led into court, which appeared in the newspaper. He said for some foolish reason, he feared another situation like LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He mentioned it to his wife and finally picked up the phone and called the Shelby County Sheriff's Office. He said he does not recall saying that he was a member of the Olympia Police, nor did he recall saying anything about being in the service with RAY. He said he knows nothing about RAY except what he has read in the papers. FRUNZ said he was born in North Dakota, but lived most of his life in Portland, Oregon. He has lived in Olympia since April, 1964. He apologized for having made the call and inconvenienced anyone. FRUNZ has no record with the Olympia Police Department



WOOD sinted that at approximately 5:15 or 5:30 p.m., on August 12, 1966, ANTHUR HAMES, Attorney, appeared at the Acronarine Supply Company and requested to speak with him. WOOD advised that he was busy and when he had completed him sale, he spoke with Mr. HAMES, who made small talk for a few minutes and then said "DOM, my man is so shook up, he can't remember smartly what time he was in this store on that Friday and Saturday afternoon. Can you remember what time he was in here?" WOOD advised that he told HAMES that "he was in here sometime in the afternoon."

VOCD stated that following this exchange, HAMES thanked him very much and then left the store. At no time did NAMES refer to him client, JAMES RARL RAY or suyone else by some but left me doubt in him (VGCD's) mind that he was referring to him client, JAMES RARL RAY.

The material which you have written for me is most helpful. With it I can re-create your escape on April 23, 1967, your walk toward Kansas City, how you reached Chicago, and how you lived there for about two months, working at the Indian Trail Restaurant in Winnetka.

I need exactly this sort of information for every other period of your life from the day you lift Chicago for Canada....This 11 months from your escape down to about March 1, 1968.

I also need some additional detail as to your way of life inside the prison during the seven years prior to your escape.

Here are more questions:

In that seven years namy for me all the people who visited you.

How often did you have a visit from somebody?

Estimate for me how many times you had a visitor during that seven years?


Did any woman ever visit you?

Immediately prior to your escape on April 23rd, when had you had your last visitor? A month? Three months? Christmas? Six months?

Tell me how and where you slept in prison? Alone in a cell? With one cell-mate? Who was your last cell-mate?

Tell me about this last cell-mate? Who? What crime was he in 12.2? Did he talk a lot? What about?
