On 5/21/68, Mrs. ANN JACOBSON, 434 Robb Avenue, Johnstown, Pa., advised SAs EARL W. GALLOWAY and JOHN S. HUGHES that for the past three weeks she has been doing domestic work for a DONALD SHAFFER and a Mrs. HELEN STANCE, at 446 Somerset Street, Johnstown, Pa. She explained that SHAFFER and STANCE are not married, but are living together; that SHAFFER is a local contractor and that he has several employees working for him who meet at the residence of 446 Somerset Street, each morning prior to going out on a particular contracting job.

Mrs. JACOBSON initially denied making any statement to anyone that the "killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING" was in any way connected with SHAFFER or his contracting group. She then advised that she might have made a statement that SHAFFER could be the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING inasmuch as he drinks excessively and has made statements that he could see nothing wrong with KING's assassination. Mrs. JACOBSON stated that all of SHAFFER's workmen are in their late teens or early 20's; that none of them look like JAMES EARL RAY, but that SHAFFER bears some slight resemblance to the subject.

On 5/22/68, Detective HAROLD BERKEYBILE, Police Department, Johnstown, Pa., advised that he is personally acquainted with SHAFFER; that SHAFFER has been a fly-by-night contractor in Johnstown for many years; that one of SHAFFER's employees is his brother, JOSEPH, and that SHAFFER could not in any way be identical to JAMES EARL RAY.



On 6/4/68, WILLIAM C. DOERR, U. S. Postal Inspector, Charleston, West Va., advised that he recalls the investigation of RICHARD STANLEY and from records he stated that this was handled out of Washington, D.C. He stated it was a December 1966 case and was conducted on a complaint received from the Charleston, West Virginia, Police Department that STANLEY was molesting small girls and that he was writing and sending them obscene cards and letters.

Mr. DOERR checked his files and stated that RICHARD STANLEY called his little operation the Iris Girls Club. His sole purpose was to get little girls involved with him. The file indicated that STANLEY is a mental case and is very peculiar. He is amout 60 years of age and has been employed for many years in the press room of the Charleston Gazette, Charleston, West Va., where he was last known to have been employed in 1966.

Mr. DOERR said that STANLEY resides at Route 2, Box 276B (Loudendale) Charleston, West Va., with relatives and he is not married. He said that STANLEY's only operated locally and that he was the only man involved but that the local police had investigated him because he allegedly had attempted to molest small girls...

Mr. DOERn said he does not know what disposition was made this case and further details would have to come from Washington.
