



He stated that he thought the code this laundry used with this machine was as follows:

LA would indicate the lot number - this number probably went up to 20 ie 20A. The lot number would then be changed to 1B.

The number following the letter would be the bundle number identifying the customer to whom this bundle belonged.

Thusly the first customer who came in when the machine was first put into operation would be assigned the number IA-I meaning his particular laundry would be in the first lot and his bundle had the number I on it identifying as that particular customers laundry. This lot number would go up to 20 and then a new lot number would be started which would be IB-I. During a period of time and depending on the volume of customers would be the factor determining how many people may have the same number assigned to them. It is to be noted that each time a customer brought in new laundry he would have a new number.
