

In Memphis, Mrs. Bessie Brewer, who rented a room in the flophouse to Dr. King's killer, said, "I just don't know, I just don't know if it's him," when she was shown the FBI picture. "All I noticed was that he was a neat dresser. That's all. Nothing else."

Charlie Stevens, who lives in the flophouse and saw the killer, said the photograph "doesn't register."

Have You Seen Him?

WANTED by the FBI in connection with the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., is Eric Starvo Galt, described as a loner with a taste for Western and country music, dancing and vodka.

Galt was described as white, 36, and 5 feet, 8 to 5 feet, 11 inches tall. He weighs 160 to 175 pounds.

The FBI said his language and choice of words were reported to have a "rural" quality. He was described as a neat dresser, with brown hair in a crew cut, blue eyes and a straight nose. He has a nervous habit of tugging at his ear, the FBI said.

Galt reportedly took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965, in Birmingham, Ala., during September and October, 1967, and in Long Beach, Calif., from December, 1967, to February, 1968.

The bureau warned that "Galt should be considered armed and dangerous," and any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the FBI.

It is noted that Agents receiving copies of this memorandum have previously received leads to check with firms known to have or have had Thermo-Seal marking machines for a laundry or dry cleaner utilizing the code O2B-6 or D2B-6.

By airtel dated 4/19/68 the Memphis Division advised that the FBI Laboratory had advised a pillow case and a bed sheet were found in the trunk of a 1966 white Mustang automobile registered to ERIC STARVO GALIF, which had been located in Atlanta on 4/11/68.

These items recovered in the Mustang had a Thermo-Seal laundry tape of approximately the same size as the tapes on the underwear previously recovered but the ones on the pillow case and bed sheet are yellow in color and contain the code "20R-3" on the Thermo-Seal tape.
