




At 8:50 PM, 4/9/68 NELSON KIRKWOOD, News Director, WIL News advised he had learned through ABC news, New York, that LYNN RAY CLEVELAND, 2351 Whitmore Place, St. Louis, Missouri is in custody at Joplin, Missouri as a suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

CIE VELAND was arpasted at Joplin after a call from the operators of the CORAL MOTEL, Joplin, who claimed that CLEVELAND acted strangely while watching the funeral of Dr. King. Kirkwood stated his impression is that KIRKWOOD-is-a CLEVELAND is a mental case.

Kirkwood furthur advised that he checked the address given by CLEVELAND, and found a listing to CHARLES HYSLOP, 2351 Whitmore Pl. Mrs. Hyslop confirmed that CLEVELAND rents a room from her, but declined to furnish any other information.

Kirkwood stated he also telephoned Joplin where he talked to the Chief of Police. He confirmed that CLEVELAND is in custody in that city and would be held a maximum of 20 hours unless charged. The Chief reported that the FBI is presently interrogating CLEVELAND. He furnished the suspects DOB as At Palmer, Texas.

At 10:20 a.m., on April 10, 1968, Mrs. HELEN WALSA, in charge of the Travelers Aid Society at the Greyhound Bus Station, advised that she had some information relative to LYNN RAY CLEVELAND, who had been picked up, she believes in Kansas City, Missouri, in connection with the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

She stated that CLEVELAND has been in her office on several occasions, the last time being on January 20, '1968, at which time he indicated he had been living with people by the name of FISHBACK, at 2337 Whitmore Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri. She said CLEVELAND gave the address of his parents as Box 9260, Palmer, Texas.

Mrs. WALSH stated that CLEVELAND told her he was a mental case and had been in a mental hospital, place unknown. He further stated that he had attended Baylor University and was a hard-core Southern Baptist.

Mrs. WALSH stated that she believes the newspaper indicated that CLEVELAND was released after being questioned but she thought the information in her files may be of some assistance to this office.

He stated that this individual is a young white man, about 5'10", 160 lbs., with sandy receding hair.

The caller stated that he knows nothing specific which would associate JOHNS with the killing of KING and does not know where JOHNS lives or what type of automobile he drives.

A review of the Army service record for DONNIE LEON my Serial Number , on file at the Military HARDEN, Army Serial Number Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, disclosed that HARDEN served in the U.S. Army on active duty from May 1, 1958 at Montgomery, Alabama, to honorable discharge from active duty and transferred to the Reserve at Oakland, California, March 31, 1961. He thereafter entered on active duty in the Army at Montgomery, Alabama on May 22, 1963, and served until honorable discharge due to hardship at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, June 4, 1965. Rank at time of discharge was Specialist Fourth Grade. He also had inactive service in the Alabama National Guard, April 21, 1955 to April 30, 1958, and May 15, 1962 to December 17, 1962. He served in the inactive U. S. Army Reserve from April 1, 1961 to April 30, 1962. His military occupation was listed as Communications Center Specialist. His civilian occupation was listed as Welder, Farmer and Musician (singing and guitar). The file failed to show any courts-martial or absences without official leave but did indicate a reduction in rank in December, 1962, while in the National Guard due to inefficiency. No details appear.

Top secret clearance was granted him on September 30, 1958, based on a background investigation completed September 24, 1958 by the Army Security Agency, Third Army Area, Dossier Number

He has blood group "O". He received an expert's badge in the M1 carbine. He had foreign service of one year, eight months, and 15 days in the Pacific Theater.

A letter from his wife appeared in the file dated April 2, 1965, addressed to Lieutenant General J. L. RICHARDSON, Fort Houston, Texas, which alleged that HARDEN had made false statements in applying for a hardship discharge. She stated HARDEN had indicated he was going to run his father's firm in Evergreen, Alabama, and that she was a nervous wreck worrying about him going overseas, all of which was untrue. She stated that he had a job waiting for him at Brown and Root Construction Company as a heavy equipment operator. She further stated that he had been a different man since his service in Okinawa as he had beaten her several times and had spent one night in jail on arrest by the Alamo Heights Police Department in San Antonio, Texas for having beaten her. She stated his temper and filthy language were terrible. She stated she had tried to leave him but had been told by him he would kill her and all three of their children if she did. She stated he purchased a rifle and cartridges the following day. She stated he had torn up several pieces of their furniture, half of her clothing, broken her watch, and had choked her on several occasions. She further alleged mistreatment of their 15 month old son.

The file further reflected a statement by HARDEN that his wife had previously suffered a complete nervous

breakdown and that she apparently was approaching a similar breakdown at the time of his discharge.

At 6.30 PM on 4/6/68, a telephone call was received by SA SPURGEON J. PETERSON from a Mr. MARVIN BOWLEN, of 403 North Van Buren Street, Kirkwood, Missouri, telephone TA 1-6926. Mr. BOWLEN stated that he had a friend who owned a farm at Libertyville Neighborhood, which is located between Farmington and Fredericktown, Missouri. This friend had contacted BOWLEN and said he had observed a sketch of UNSUB in this case and believes it to be a likeness of one SHELBY BELKEN, who lives near his farm at Libertyville Neighborhood. Mr. BOWLEN stated that his friend refused to permit his identity to be revealed and he, BOWLEN, also wanted to remain anonymous insofar as making this complaint is concerned. BOWLEN further related that he has a good friend who is a reporter for the "St. Louis Post-Dispatch" newspaper and said that he would like to tell his friend about this matter in order that he could get in on the story when SHELBY BELKEN was arrested. wanted to know that if BELKEN were arrested if his friend could collect the reward that has been offered in connection with the apprehension of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING. BOWLEN asked that he be advised as soon as this matter had been "checked out".

Mr. BOWLEN was informed that the FBI would not be able to check back with him at this time as we do not discuss results of our investigations. It was suggested to him that he not contact the newspapers until it was determined whether or not there was any credence to his friend's suspicions.

Resident Agent DOUGLAS ROSENBERGER was telephonically contacted immediately and furnished the above information with instructions to locate the BELKEN family and determine whether or not SHELBY BELKEN could possibly be involved in this case. Thereafter on the evening of 4/6/68, SA ROSENBERGER telephoned the writer and stated that he had been in touch with the MSHP and that they had, at his request, located the BELKEN family on a farm at Libertyville Neighborhood and had determined that there was no resemblance between the sketch appearing in the newspaper of UNSUB and SHELBY BELKEN. They told SA

ROSENBERGER that SHELDY BELKEN is 56 years old, that he has one son, JAMES BELKEN, living with him who is 18 years old, and he has a second son, PAUL BELKEN, who works for Railway Express Agency (REA), in St Louis. PAUL BELKEN is described as approximately 20 years old. Neither SHELBY nor JAMES BELKEN looked like the sketch of UNSUB. It was the opinion of the State Patrol, according to SA ROSENBERGER, that this family would have had no connection with instant case.

Chief BOB WYATT of REA, St. Louis, advised SA PETERSON that PAUL ALBERT BELKEN has been employed by his agency since 3/12/64, as a marker. His Social Security Number is

He is 28 years old and has an address of RR 1, Box 24, Imperial, Missouri. He was on duty from 6:10 AM to 2:40 PM, on both 3/29 and 3/30/68. He was off duty on 4/4/68. He stated that BELKEN is a white male, 6', 190#, brown hair, hazel eyes; in 1963 when a photograph, which is available, was taken, it showed considerable acne and pockmaking on his face, particularly on the region of his lower jaw. At that time he wore his hair in a crewcut.

On 4/8/68, at 4:55 p.m., Rev. CLYDE OSTER, First Baptist Church, 6136 Garfield, Berkeley, Mo., phone JA 2-8898 (home phone JA 1-2940), stated that at about 12:55 p.m., 4/8/68, he received a phone call from a man who identified himself as PHILLIP BANELLI (phonetic), who advised him that he was at Lambert Airport and that he had a serious problem which he wanted to discuss with a minister.

Rev. OSTER proceeded to the airport to counsel BANELLI and in the ensuing hour and a half conversation, BANELLI expounded that he had been involved with the Mafia, that he had a lot of evidence, and that he was in fear of his life.

Rev. OSTER stated BANELLI opened an attache case and showed him a number of checks. During the conversation BANELLI indicated he had a financial need whereupon Rev. OSTER refused to give him any money. BANELLI then requested Rev. OSTER to drive him into SLMO and he was driven to Ogden and Easton Avenues at about 4:30 p.m., and left the car.

BANELLI is described by Rev. OSTER as white male, age 21, 5'10" - 11" tall, 145 pounds, light brown hair, brown eyes, thin build, dark gray sport coat, tight black trousers, tattoos on forearms, and indicated he had come from New Orleans, La.

It is noted the person identifying himself as PHILLIP BANELLI appears to be identical to THOMAS ROBERT HENDERSON who contacted Rev. GIBSON in SLMO on the evening of 4/7/68. This interview was handled in substantive 44-475 with copy to instant file.


