At 9:10 pm this evening Cpl. J. E. O'CONNOR of the Fairfax County, Va. PD, on duty this evening at the Rt. 1 and Ft. Belvoir complex, stated he had learned the following from RUBY DANSBY, 9100 Richmond Highway, Ft. Belvoir, Va. who operates the Belvoir Grill at this address. She resides same address, tel. 781-5841.

She told Officer O'CONNOR that earlier this evening a man had been in the grill to eat, and that he appeared to be a "dead ringer" of the individual whose composite picture she had seen of the suspect wanted for the murder of KING. She described this man as a white, male, height 5'7" - 5'8", sandy, graying hair, thin line mustache, wearing a brown pin stripe suit, and a red-blue plaid flannel shirt. She said the man had no luggage and as far as she could ascertain he was on foot. In conversation with this individual, DANSBY said he told her he was from Knoxville and was hitchhiking his way to Florida.

OFFICER O'CONNOR stated he checked out the area, but was unable to locate the individual DANSBY spoke about. He also stated that DANSBY had set aside the dinner utensils the unknown man had used while at the grill.

ROBERT W. FERGUSON
INFORMATION CONCERNING

A source, who requested that his identity not be made known, advised Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) on March 10, 1968, that he knows a Major Robert W. Ferguson who looks exactly like the composite photograph of the assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King. He described Ferguson as a white male, brownish-red hair, blue eyes, fair complexion, slender build, six feet one inch tall, 180 pounds, about thirty to thirty-five years old, and a member of the United States Army Reserves, who is now operating the Danton China Company at 3111 Columbia Pike, Arlington, Virginia. He advised that Ferguson has been out of town for the past ten days and still has not returned. He stated that Ferguson approached an employee of the CoCo Casa Mia, 3111 Columbia Pike, Arlington, Virginia, and offered the employee a job as a cook at the Skywood Manor Inn and Motel, United States Route 2, Jefferson, New Hampshire 03583, telephone number 586-4371, which Ferguson's mother allegedly manages. He advised that Ferguson may have left Virginia to attend a meeting of the "Ridge Runners" in Florida as a card had been seen on Ferguson's desk from the "Ridge Runners". This card had a photograph of a man running along a ridge with a rifle in his hand and stated that there was a convention in Florida. Source advised that he has seen Ferguson in the uniform of an Army major on one occasion which was the weekend near the end of March when Dr. King was in Washington, D.C., in reference to the Poor People's March. He advised that Ferguson has a 1956 Lincoln Continental, white in color with New Hampshire tags. He advised that Ferguson is divorced

and has tried to date two of the waitresses at the CoCo Casa Mia. He advised that Ferguson is the boss of the Danton China Company but he cannot understand how this company does any business. He stated that the five or six employees that Ferguson has definitely do not look like the salesmen type. He advised that on the wall of Ferguson's office, although there is only one telephone, there is a large box with many terminals on it and the marking Bell Telephone.

C., and is employed at the CoCo Casa Mia, 3111 Columbia Pike, Arlington, Va. On 4/10/68, he gave the information in the LHM to SAS JOHN J. HINCHCLIFFE and WAYNE R. GILBERT and requested that his identity be protected.

WFO indices and NCIC negative re JOE L. BROWN. Indices negative re "Ridge Runners."

WFO file 124-7641, Bufile 124-8875 contains a report of SA JOHN R. ALE, dated 3/24/59, in which ROBERT WALLACE FERGUSON, date of birth [REDACTED], place of birth Lexington, Mass., who had relatives in Jefferson, New Hampshire. [This file also indicates that FERGUSON was a covert employee of the CIA from 1951 to 1959 and was being investigated for a position with International Cooperation Administration which was apparently a CIA cover.] (S)

Since WFO file indicates that FERGUSON may be a covert employee of CIA, memos being furnished to the Bureau for appropriate dissemination. (S)

Hunt for Killer Is Pressed; Memphis March Tomorrow

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — Police clamped a tight lid yesterday on information about the multistate search for Dr. Martin Luther King's killer.

And planners of tomorrow's march announced King's absence would be symbolized by a vacant spot in the ranks.

Undersecretary of Labor James Reynolds, meanwhile, arrived as President Johnson's emissary "to give whatever assistance I can in the orderly resolution" of the garbage strike which brought King here.

"Very Encouraging"

Frank Holloman, Memphis police director, described the investigation as "very encouraging" but declined to expand on the manhunt information released Friday by U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark.

"The furnishing of any more details at this time might jeopardize either the investigation or the conviction of the individual responsible," Holloman said.

Tomorrow's march — one day before King's burial in Atlanta — will begin from a temple near the death scene and work its way through downtown Memphis.

Demonstration leaders said 50,000 people may participate — including several movie stars.

"There will be a vacant spot in the march to symbolize the absence of Dr. King," said Jerry Fanion, one of the organizers.

Will Head Parade

Another spokesman said Dr. Ralph Abernathy, who replaced King as leader of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, would walk at the head of the parade with a vacant spot at his side.

The federal court order allowing the demonstration requires the marchers to maintain a column four abreast.

"About 5,000 persons are flying in from New York on chartered planes," said the Rev. Ralph Jackson.

"People will be coming from far and near, by bus, by car, by plane," said Bayard Rustin, a close friend of King and organi-

zer of the massive march on Washington in 1963.

Claude Armour, Gov. Buford Ellington's special assistant and former Memphis police commissioner, met with local law enforcement officials, National Guard commanders and march sponsors yesterday to coordinate plans.

Armour declined to say how many troops or police will be deployed on the march route.

Reuther Expected

"Walter Reuther, president of the United Auto Workers Union, definitely will be here for the march," said Tommy Powell, president of the Memphis Labor Council.

"There will be about 15 other top union officials from around the country and if George Meany cannot come, he'll send a delegation from his office." Meany is president of the AFL-CIO.

Powell also announced a memorial service for King in the 50,000-seat Mid-South Stadium this afternoon. It was being jointly sponsored by businessmen, King's followers, organized labor and other groups.

The eight-week strike by 1,300 Memphis garbage collectors brought King here the week before last and a downtown march triggered a brief riot. King returned last week to plan tomorrow's march, but was gunned down Thursday night at his motel.

Died Within Seconds

Dr. Jerry Francisco, Memphis medical examiner, yesterday released results of the autopsy on King and said the Nobel Peace Prize winner died within seconds after being hit by a single bullet.

"Tracing the path of the bullet leads me to believe Dr. King was dead before he arrived at the hospital," Francisco said.

"There might have been some sign of life from a medical standpoint, and this prompted the attending physician to make every effort possible to save him."

The bullet pierced King's neck and traveled downward,

trating his spinal cord and lodging in the skin on the left side, the autopsy showed.

The city, after a third night of curfew and few incidents, remained calm yesterday.

The first fatality of the Memphis outburst was recorded when Ellis Tate, a 26-year-old Negro, died of wounds he suffered Thursday night. Police said Tate was shot when officers ordered him to drop a rifle and he reacted by firing it.

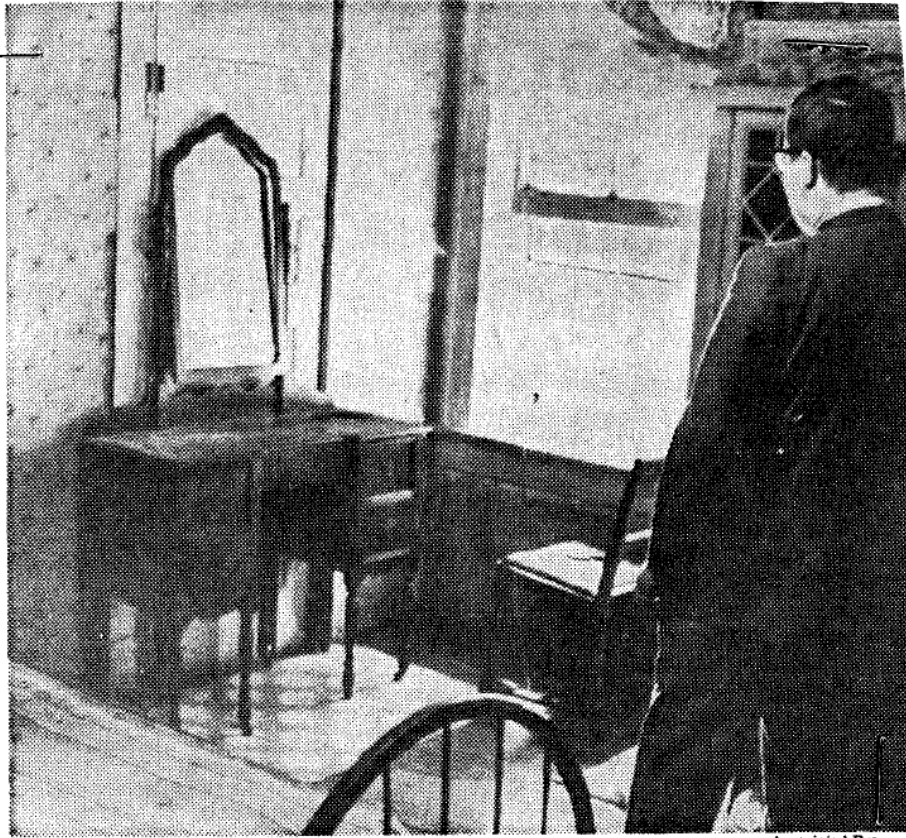

He advised that at about 7:30 p.m., 4/9/68, a white man driving a Plymouth or Pontiac with Maryland tags came to his home and asked to store four guns in his garage until 7:00 a.m., 4/10/68. Shelton looked at two of the guns, one a high powered rifle and one a shot gun. He did not look at the other two guns. Shelton said he is self-employed as a building contractor, suspects there is something irregular in the matter, and doesn't want to get involved. He indicated he did not know the person who left the guns.

It was suggested to Shelton that he call the Metropolitan Police immediately in view of the 7:00 a.m. time set to pick up the guns. He said he would call police immediately.

ACTION

Information was relayed to SA Don Bassett, Washington Field Office, who advised he would pass information to Intelligence Group, Metropolitan Police. For information.

Above is caption of case relating to the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. The Bureau has instructed that under no circumstances should anyone be told this investigation is in connection with captioned matter.

Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., was murdered at Memphis, Tennessee at about 6:03 p.m. on 4/4/68, by a single shot from a 30.06 rifle fired from a rooming house in the vicinity of KING's motel. KING was standing on a second floor deck at the time he was shot. The rifle and other items possessed by the killer who registered in the rooming house as JOHN WILLARD were abandoned at or near the rooming house. The killer is reported to have fled in a white Mustang automobile. The gun was purchased in Birmingham, Alabama by a HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER.

Investigation has disclosed one ERIC STARVO GALT was in Birmingham during the Fall of 1967 and was registered at a motel near Memphis the night before KING's murder. He reportedly resembles unknown subject in this matter.

Unknown subject is described as white male, age 26-32, 5'11", 160-170 pounds, medium build, dark brown or black hair combed straight back without a part.

WFO has been instructed to contact all criminal, security, and racial informants with specific emphasis directed toward informants in known hate groups.

All Agents promptly contact all informants or potential informants and advise case Agent by r/s of negative results. Positive information should receive immediate and preferred handling, utilizing teletypes.
