IN ONE, SIXTYSIX, HE ENTERED ON ACTIVE DUTY, USMC, UNDER  
THE ENLISTED RESERVE PROGRAM, SIX MONTHS ACTIVE DUTY TOUR AND  
COMPLETED THIS TRAINING ON DECEMBER TWENTY, SIXTYSIX. AT TIME  
OF RELEASE, HE WAS ASSIGNED TO COMPANY F, SECOND BATTALION,  
SECOND MARINES, SECOND MARINE DIVISION, FMF, CAMP LEJEUNE. DURING  
EARLY PART OF DECEMBER HIS OUTFIT WENT TO VIEQUE ON MANEUVERS AND  
APPROXIMATELY THIRTY RESERVISTS REMAINED AT CAMP LEJEUNE PROCESSING

FOR THEIR DISCHARGE. DURING THIS PERIOD, AN M FOURTEEN RIFLE WAS STOLEN AND EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED BY MILITARY AUTHORITIES. THIEF NOT IDENTIFIED. IN CONVERSATION WITH OTHER MEMBERS OF THE RESERVISTS, A MARINE RESERVIST FROM COLUMBIA, S. C., NAME NOT RECALLED, WAS MENTIONED AS POSSIBLY HAVING STOLEN THE RIFLE. THE UNSUB MARINE WAS FRIENDLY WITH ONE DAVE PARRISH, WHO PISKORSKI RECALLED AS HAVING RESIDENCE IN EITHER GEORGIA OR ALABAMA, AND THEY OFTEN WENT ON WEEKEND LEAVES TOGETHER. SHORTLY BEFORE PISKORSKI'S RELEASE FROM ACTIVE DUTY AND WHILE TALKING WITH PARRISH, PARRISH TOLD PISKORSKI THAT HE WAS CONCERNED REGARDING THE UNSUB MARINE SINCE IN CONVERSATION WITH PARRISH, HE HAD MENTIONED HE WAS GOING TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PISKORSKI ALSO ADVISED THAT IN BULL SESSIONS DURING THEIR SIX MONTHS TRAINING, THE UNSUB MARINE HAD STATED THAT HE HAD ONCE SHOT A NEGRO AND THAT HE HAD ONCE RUN OVER A NEGRO WITH HIS AUTOMOBILE. PISKORSKI DESCRIBED THIS INDIVIDUAL AS HAVING A DEEP-SEATED PREJUDICE AGAINST THE NEGRO PEOPLE.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF THIS UNSUB FURNISHED BY PISKORSKI AS FIVE FEET ELEVEN INCHES TO SIX FEET TALL, WHITE, MALE, LIGHT BROWN HAIR, SLIM, ONE HUNDRED FIFTY TO ONE HUNDRED SIXTY POUNDS AND IN HIS MIDDLE TWENTIES.

PISKORSKI ADVISED THAT ALL OF THE RESERVISTS WERE RELEASED TO INACTIVE DUTY DURING THE MONTH OF DECEMBER AND THAT IT WAS HIS RECOLLECTION THAT UNSUB AND PARRISH WERE RELEASED PRIOR TO HIS OWN RELEASE WHICH WAS ON DECEMBER TWENTY, SIXTYSIX.

HE ALSO POINTED OUT THAT UNSUB MARINE HAD ATTAINED HIGH MARKS IN THE OUTFIT ON THE RIFLE RANGE AND WAS AN EXPERT MARKSMAN. PISKORSKI COULD RECALL NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND INDICATED HE WOULD REVIEW PAPERS IN ADDRESS BOOK IN ATTEMPT TO DEVELOP FURTHER IDENTIFYING DATA RE BOTH INDIVIDUALS.

SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:

Miss GENEVIEVE M. RUTHERFORD, Bookkeeper, Standard Business Machines Manufacturing Co., hereinafter called SBM, furnished sworn signed statement concerning her knowledge of checks withheld and not issued to creditors and other irregularities. SMUDA determined to be GEORGE J. F. SMUDA, whose home address is 3963 West Erie St., Chicago, Ill. Examination of SBM's records reflected that all purchases of \$1,000 or over charged to Air Force contract #AF 30(635)-894, were correctly applicable thereto.
