and appearance," Cherpes "He always wore sporty clothes and a tie. He was always pleasant and I never knew of him drinking."

Cherpes said Galt "didn't say much about his family affairs, only that he was divorced. He only talked about the weather, never about politics or racial troubles.

He said Galt staved at his rooming house at 2608 Highland ave. from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7 last year.

He said that during September, Galt received a prepaid package in the mail from Chicago. He said it weighed 20 to 25 pounds, was about two feet long and one foot wide. The next day, Cherpes said, Galt told him it was the wrong merchandise and he planned to send it back.

In October, Cherpes said, Galt told him he was leaving for Mobile, Ala., to seek a job. Galt said he expected a letter from Chicago and asked Cherpes to hold it for him.

"I was puzzled for a while

where to mail ti," Cherpes said. "I didn't have an address (for Galt). So I held the letter for a week, and returned it."

Cherpes said it appeared to him the letter contained a check.

When he received the letter, Cherpes said, he went to his file to look for Galt's registration card and found it. But when FBI agents came to him last week. Cherpes said it was missing.

Cherpes earlier denied knowing Galt. He said this was because the FBI has asked him not to say anything about the man. But he said the FBI had no authority to stop him. His rooming house was bolted and he refused to admit anyone this afternoon.

He said Galt was a natty dresser who always paid his \$27 a week room and board

in cash, on time.

"When he was here, on the third or fourth day, he asked me if I would drive his car downtown for him to take a driver's test," Cherpes said.

"He was a new man to Alabama and to Birmingham and also a customer. Cherpes continued, "and I wanted to help him on that basis. If he had asked for recommendation, my would have investigated more closely."

Cherpes said that when-Galt arrived at the rooming house, he told him his last job was in the shipyards at Pascagoula, Miss. However, Ingalls Shipbuilding Co. at Pascagoula said it had never: hired a man by that name.

FBI May Be Chasing Phantom

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., April 16 (UP) — An artist's conception of the man wanted in the sniper slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. 'looked exactly like' Eric Starvo Galt, the elusvie central figure in a nationwide manhunt, according to Galt's landlord.

Federal agents, still refusing coment on the having a southern drawl and a pointed nose— the investigation, appeared no closer to locating Dr. King's assassin yesterday.

As agents continued to follow cold trails, it seemed more likely that Galt may have been an elaborately devised alias and that such a person existed only in a Birmingham rooming house in certain Alabama state records.

Galt cannot be traced before he took a Birmingham room last August or after his abandoned car was impounded by the FBI in Atlanta last week.

Galt, claiming to have come to Alabama from Louisiana, bought his white Mustang in Birmingham and applied for and was granted a state driver's license.

Little else is known of the figure, described as having a suthern drawl and a pointed nose—the same general description as Dr. King's assassin.

The car, found in an Atlanta housing projects the description of one seen leaving a Memphis flophouse from where the fatal shot was fired at Dr. King April 4.

Secretive FBI Follows Cold Trail

ATLANTA, April 15 (UPI) — Federal agents, intensifying the largest manhunt in FBI history, today maintained stringent silence as they followed a cold trail in the hunt for the sniper assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The hun tfor elusive Eric Starvo Galt continues, altho there is no warrant outstanding for the unemployed merchant seaman.

Police in Jacksonville, Fla. said yesterday two hitchnikers arrested on vagrancy charges had no connection with the case. They were arrested after a Negro motorist reported one of the men looked just like an artist's sketch of the murderer. Mr. Galt, if that is his real name, appears to hold the key to the investigation. His car was impounded last week after it was found abandoned in a housing project here. The car answered the description of one seen fleeing Memphis, April 4 with Dr. King's killer.

The Nobel Peace Prize winner was shot to death as he stood on the balcony of a motel in Memphis.

The murder weapon, a 30.06 caliber Remington automatic rifle, is believed to have been purchased in Birmingham shortly before the slaying.

King Clues Point to Hired Killer

MEMPHIS, April 16-There is growing speculation among Memphis police detectives that Martin Luther King's assassin was a disinterested professional killer-not a racist ideologue-who left an elaborate trail of phony clues to confuse his pursuers.

They won't say who they think hired the killer or why, but the evidence, they say, points to a well-paid professional job.

Frank C. Holloman, director of Fire

and Police has maintained a stony

silence on progress of the April 4 murder investigation, as has his chief of detectives, William Huston. But sources in the department indicate that the "hired killer" theory is gaining momentum.

One notion is that the killer began his preparation six or eight months ago by dissolving his real identity and manufacturing a new personality known as "Eric Starvo Galt, 36, unemployed merchant marine."

Surrounding himself with phony credentials, he waited patiently in various cities for the right opportunity to fulfill his assignment.

In Birmingham, meanwhile, Jefferson County Sheriff Mel Bailey told United Press International that there is evidence that the assassin was in Birmingham while Dr. King was jailed in the city last October and November.

Bailey said he believes the murder may have been the result of a conspiracy and that Birmingham could well have been the original site planned for the assassination.

Dr. King came to Birmingham to serve a five-day sentence for holding a demonstration on Easter Sunday 1963,

in violation of a court order. Bailey kept Dr. King under heavy guard throughout his stay in Birmingham.

The sheriff said his theory is only conjecture but that "it is based on evidence uncovered so far in the case."

The right opportunity came April 4 in Memphis. Dr. King had arrived the day before, and television and local newspapers had announced the motel and room number where Dr. King was staying.

The assassin rented a room in an adjacent building under the name "John Willard," fired the fatal shot and fled, leaving an enormous trail of finger prints, clothing, binoculars, a rifle and an expended shell in his wake.

Federal authorities said today they are satisfied John Willard and Eric Starvow Galt are the same person.

Memphis detectives say evidence that the killer was hired at a substantial price is reflected by his ability to purchase a "white mustang" automobile and follow Dr. King around the country for several months without apparently holding a job.

The detectives are leery of the physical evidence left by the killer

"He was supposed to have shot King with a pump rifle," one said. "Well, there was a spent shell found on the bathroom floor of the rooming house, and a pump rifle won't eject a shell automatically. It won't come out unless you pull back on the pump mechanism."

He noted that the discarded Remington 30.06 pump rifle found on the street near the rooming house was inside a Browning automatic rifle packing box. He suggested that the assassin actually had two rifles, using the Browning automatic to kill Dr. King and planting the Remington as a red herring. Even if the expended shell found in the bathroom matches the Remington, he said, the killer could have fired it at an earlier date and planted the shell to match the Remington.

The FBI has the Remington and other physical evidence at its laboratories in Washington and has not revealed its findings.

Memphis detectives look at the assassin as an incredibly "cool" character who didn't seem to mind being obvious. Dressed neatly in a business suit and necktie, he rented an \$8.50-a-week


room in a flophouse, paying in advance with a clean, new \$20 bill. He then proceeded to leave finger and hand prints around the bathroom and dump a bag full of clothing, a rifle with telescopic sight and a pair of binoculars on the street as he fled.

"It was better than a television show, the way he did it," said one officer.


Most of the items dumped in the street, they speculate, will lead to blind alleys. The killer was casual about his finger and hand prints either because he is an alien or because he thinks he is one of the few American adults who has not been fingerprinted at one time or another, they say.

They discount the possibility of a Ku Klux Klan conspiracy in the assassination. "Shucks," said one, "with all this reward money (\$100,000) being offered here, if it was the Klan, they would have turned each other in a long time ago."

In Atlanta, meanwhile, two cab drivers said they gave rides to the man identified as Galt immediately after the assassination. They made the claims after identifying Galt from sketches circulated by the FBI.

At 12:18 PM this date, RICHARD SCOTT, National Science Foundation, 1800 K NW, telephone code 183 extensions 7835 of 7836, telephonically advised that a friend of his who he refused to identify but inadvertently referred to as "HERB" had recently commented to him that a former schoolmate at American University had been released from jail about the time that GALT, subject in captioned case, has been baced back to: about August, 1967.

Caller said the person involved is one JOHN SWEENEY (first name may be different) who had had a lover's quarrel with his date and had stabbed and killed her. She was JUDY HOBBARD, the daughter of a Navy Admiral and the case had received wide newspaper publicity. As SCOTT recalled SWEENEY had received sentence on a second degree murder charge. SCOTT's friend recalled that SWEENEY had been released from jail in about August, 1967. The friend noted the similarity in appearance between SWEENEY and the published pictures of suspect in captioned case. SCOTT noted that the age would be approximately correct.

SCOTT said his friend had had SWEENEY as a classmate in about 1960 and the friend had subsequently been drafted into the Army and was serving at Fort Knox, Ky., at the time of the murder of HUBBARD. He has not seen SWEENEY since about 1960. The friend commented that SWEENEY was of the temperament that could do such a deed, illustrating by saying that SWEENEY might see an ant on the sidewalk and comment "That is only an ant and it must die" whereupon he would step on the ant and kill it.

SCOTT further commented that if SWEENEY's name acutally was JOHN he wished to note that one of suspect's names was JOHN WILLARD and that a person looking for an alias hurridly might use his own first name and attach the name of some familiar object to it - in this case possibly the WILLARD hotel which used to be a spot where the "swing" set used to congregate.







A fugitive warrant charging Eric Starvo Galt with conspiracy in the murder of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was obtained yesterday by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

The announcement by Attorney General Ramsey Clark was the first official assertion that Dr. King's death in Memphis on April 4 was the result of a conspiracy. Shortly after the murder Clark declared that the killing was committed by one man, acting alone.

The FBI complaint charges that the conspiracy was hatched on or about March 29 in Birmingham between Galt "and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother." FBI spokesmen would not elaborate on the identity of the alleged conspirator.

Photos Released

Simultaneously with the announcement of the filing of the complaint, the FBI released two photographs of Galt in what officials surmised to be bartender's garb—a formal jacket and black tie. The suspect in the photograph was identified as Galt "also known as Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard."

Five hours after the FBI announcement here, Galt was charged with first-degree murder in a state warrant issued in Memphis. District Attorney Phil Canale filed the murder charge. Murder is a capital crime in Tennessee.

The FBI statement said that Galt bought a 1966 white Mus-tang, a major clue in the case from a resident of Birming ham on Aug. 30, 1967. Between the time of purchase and the day the car was found abandoned in Atlanta on April 12 the Mustang's odometer recorded 19,000 miles, according to the FBI.

Galt's travels in the Mustang included trips to Los Angeles, New Orleans, Birmingham, Mexico, Memphis and Atlanta, FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and April 4, the FBI said, and then he left for Atlanta.







PRI Cortez stated that unsub caller who claimed to be Galt appeared to have a southern accent and he believed he was a white male.


