Results of Examination:

Qc36 was found to have been recorded at a non-standard speed on g-track recorder and contained an interfering hum. A copy of Qc36 was made by playing back Qc36 on a variable speed recorder adjusting the speed for a natural sound and equalizing the frequency response to enhance intelligibility.

It is noted that one portion of Qc36 near the middle of the recording appears to be either part of some prior recording that was not recorded over or part of a recording made over the original recording. The material during this section of the tape appears unrelated to other parts of the tape.

A determination as to whether any of the recorded material on Qc36 relates to the assassination of Kennedy was not attempted by the Laboratory since it is felt personnel in the Los Angeles Office familiar with the case would be in a better position to make such determination.


