On June 12, 1968, an individual identifying himself as NORMAN WEXLER, residence 963 Lexington Avenue, New York, New York, telephone number LO 4-3250, called the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and stated that he is a free-lance playwright and also that he is free lance in advertising. He stated that he was a classmate of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY at Harvard in 1948; that he had gone to California on a voluntary basis to help with the KENNEDY campaign a few days prior to Senator KENNEDY's assassination; and that he was in the Ambassador Hotel on the night of the assassination.

WEXLER stated that there was no security at the Ambassador Hotel and that when the police came in, they acted as though they were "morons". WEXLER stated that he was in a room near the shooting and that he did not see the shooting nor hear the shots. WEXLER went on to state that he had the theory that SIRHAN SIRHAN was a member of Communist International.

Mrs. Jones is employed with a business service that develops and prints film. This service is variously known as BEACON PHOTO SERVICE and SCOT PHOTO SERVICE, 482 Sunrise Highway, Rockville Center. This is a national mail order business.

Part of her duties require Mrs. Jones to review prints that appear

damaged or faulty. Toward the close of last week she came across the attached 2 prints, both of which ^{apparently} came from the same set. The first print is a floor scene of a group of individuals carrying placards at a rally for Robert F. Kennedy. The second depicts in her opinion a photograph of Senator Kennedy, taken from an elevated position. She thought that this picture was possibly taken in Los Angeles. She further theorized that the woman directly in back of the ^{figure of} Kennedy ~~photograph~~ on the photograph appeared to be wearing a reddish pink dress with larger ^{blue} polka dots and could possibly be the mysterious missing witness.

Mrs. Jones furnished the foregoing to her employer who in general

advised her not to get involved or to involve the company. Due to this attitude on the part of her employer Mrs. Jones is most anxious that her identity be concealed.

Mrs. Jones pointed out that it was not possible to determine the identity of the person who had sent in the film for processing. She further pointed out that the service was national in scope and that it could not be determined where the film had been sent from or where the picture had been taken. She concluded that the prints were worthless thrown away and that she was offering them to the FBI for any investigative value that they might have.

He stated that it appeared that the case was being handled as a Civil Rights matter and he believed that it was not a definite Civil Rights case, therefore, in the future every effort should be made to obtain information and photographs from the requested sources so that all available information will be available to the Bureau to answer any questions put forth. He also indicated that in the future that any photographs submitted to the Bureau should be submitted in duplicate so that the Bureau will have its own copy of all photographs.
