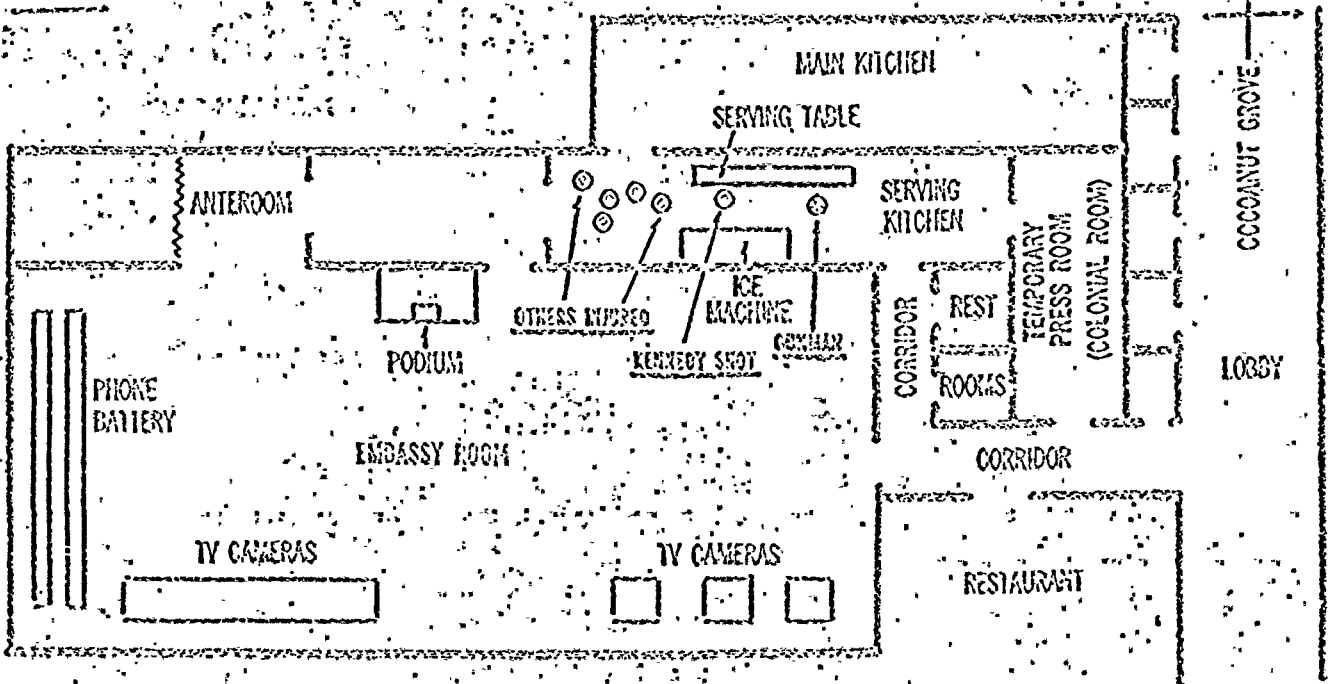


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

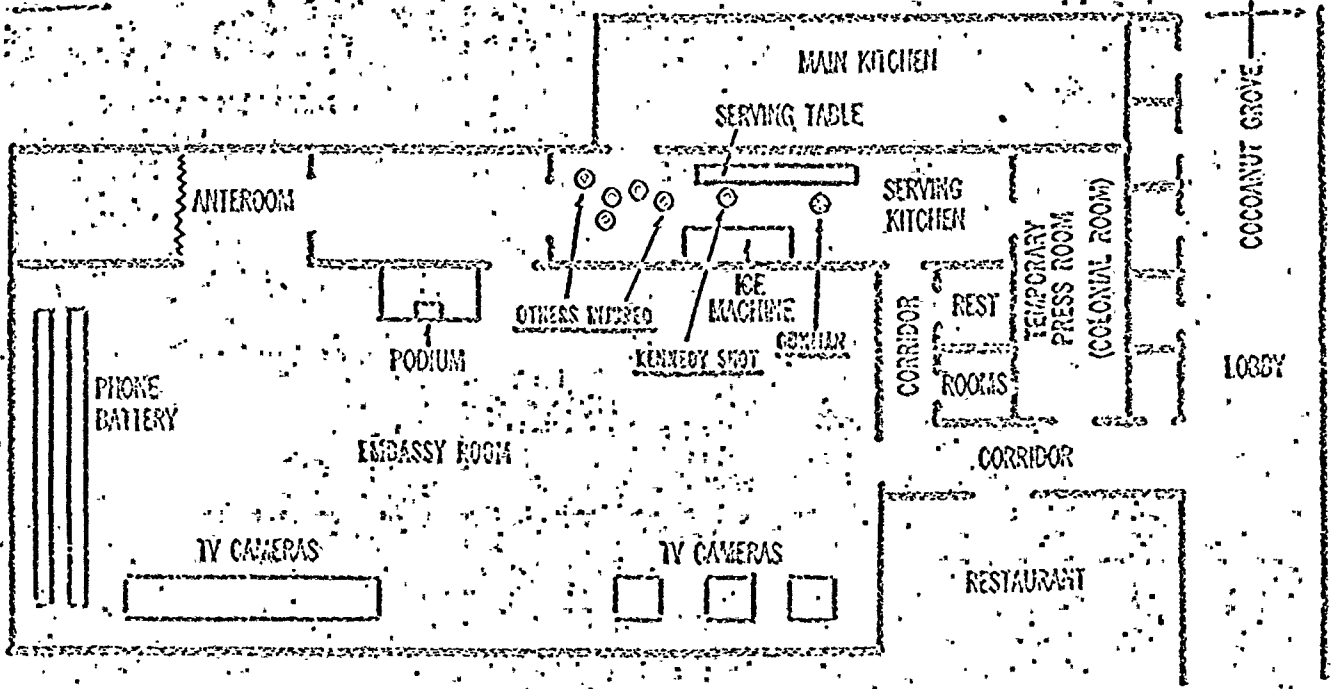


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

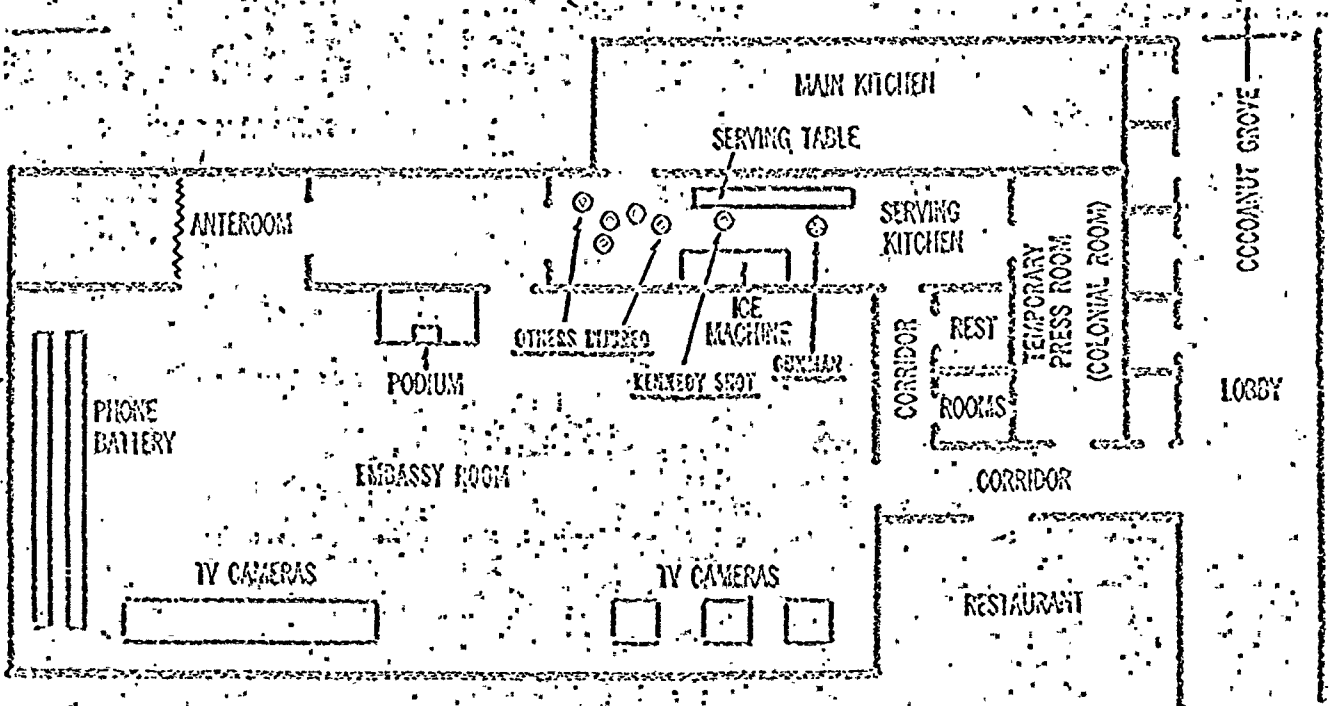


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

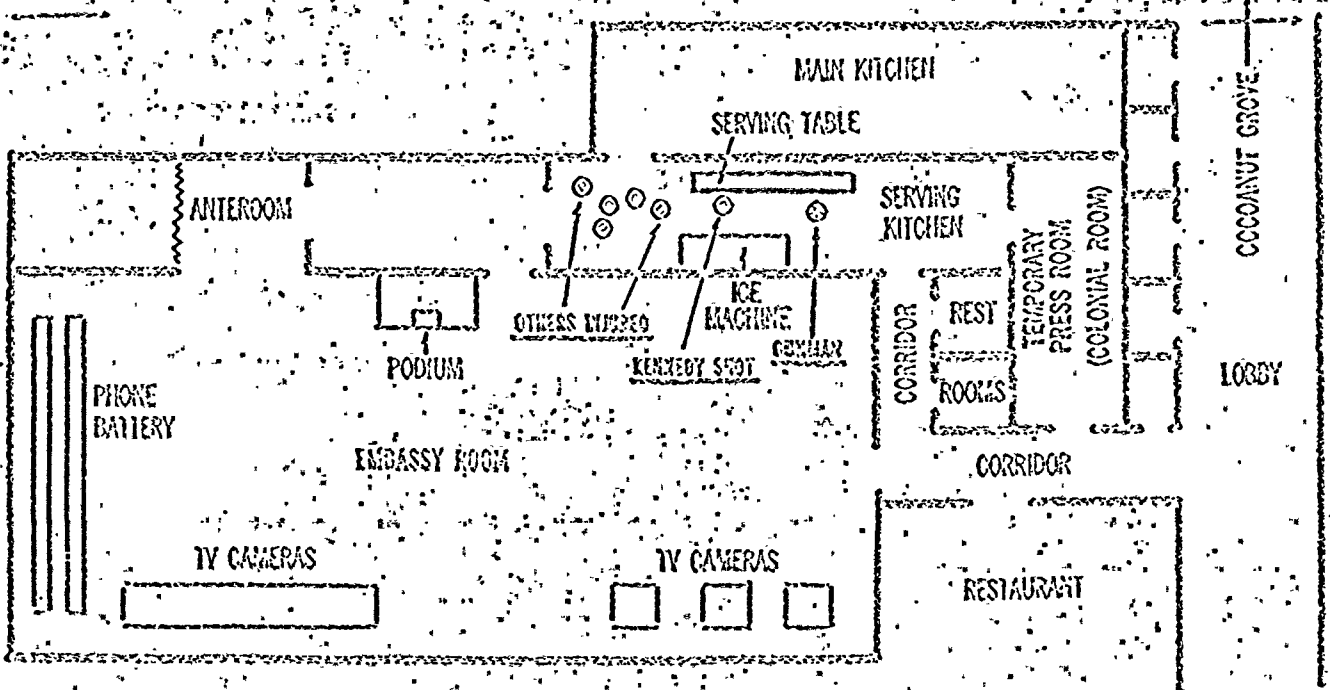


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

Wainwright believed that Sirhan Sirhan could be observed in the photograph and that he appeared to be with another male. Wainwright assumed that they were together because neither was dressed for the occasion while everyone else was. Wainwright was not certain but believed that the photograph was published.

Mr. Richard Pollard, Head of Photographers, Life Magazine, New York, N. Y. stated that there was such a picture but that it was concluded that it was not Sirhan. There were two pictures taken at the Rafferty meeting, both by Paul Glickman, a free lance photographer. Pollard is no longer in possession of the pictures. Glickman can be located through Gale Rosenberg, a parttime researcher for Life Magazine at 9570 Wilshire Blvd, Beverly Hills, Calif., tel.#213-CR3-1530. Life Magazine office in Beverly Hills may have a copy of the photographs but Pollard doubts it. New York is taking no further action as to the picture.

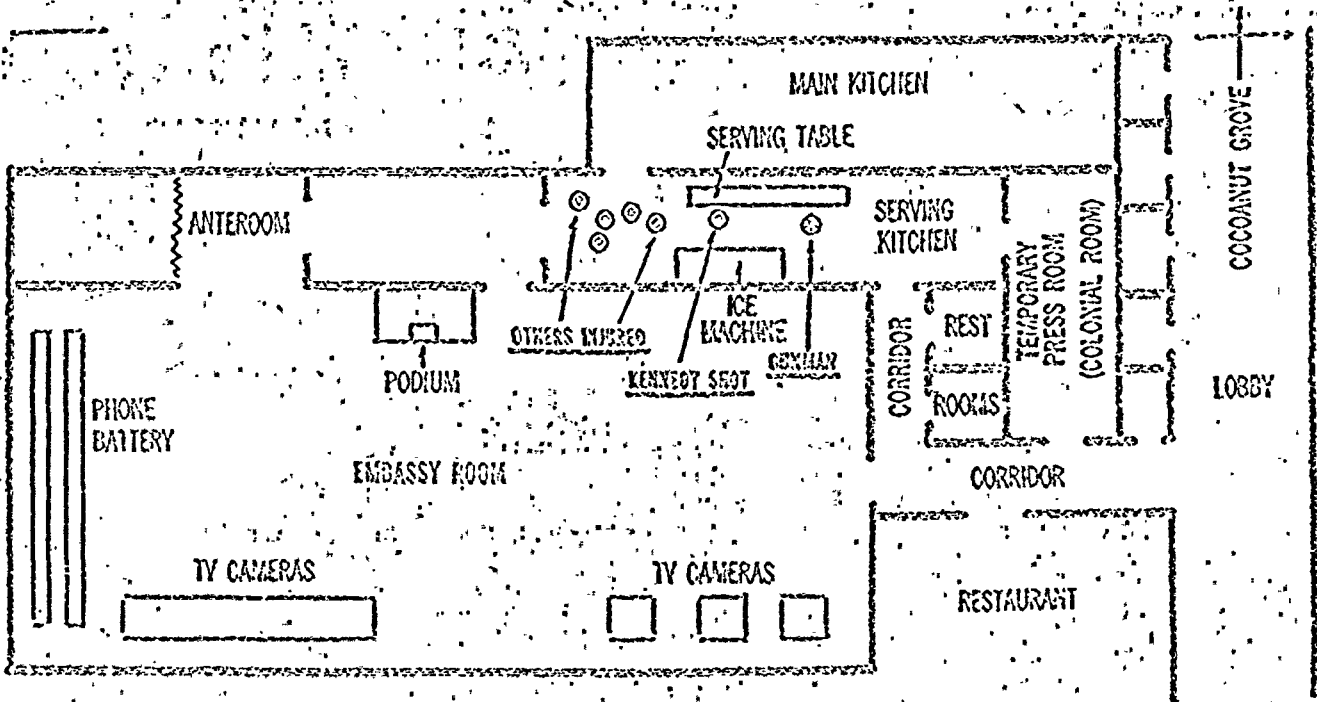


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy

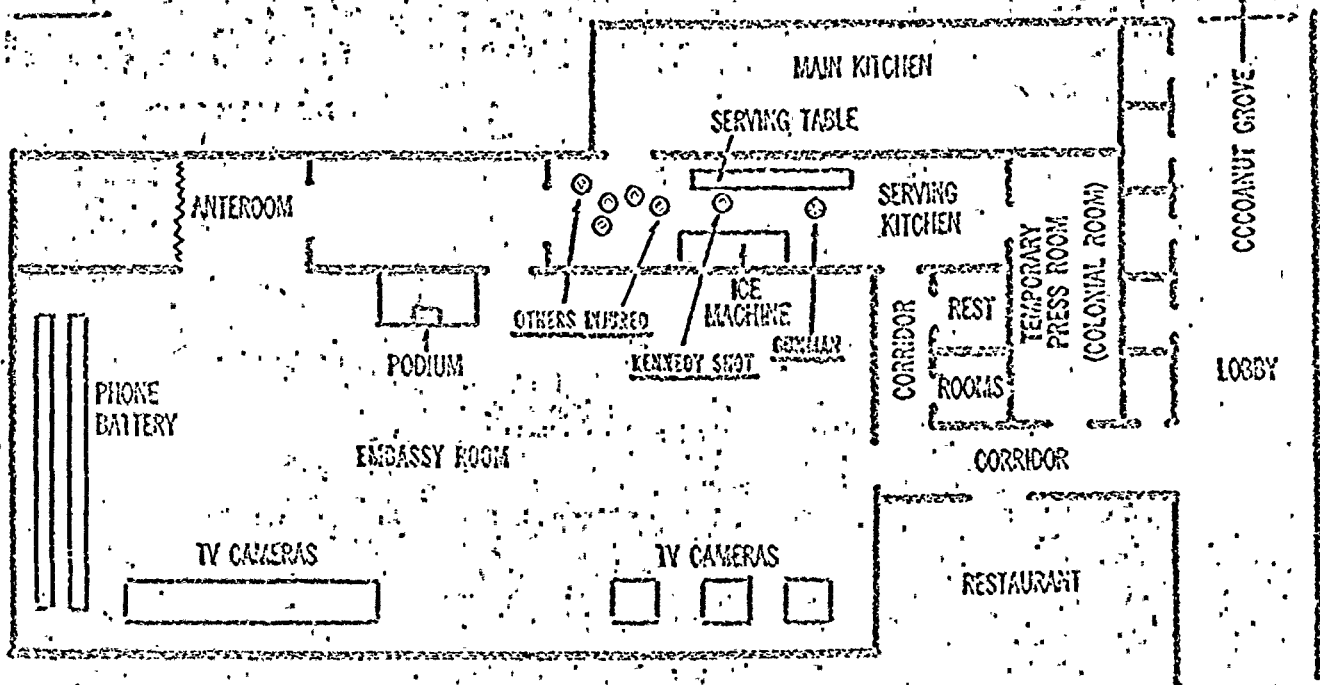


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy
