On this date at 9:40 PM, MST, anonymous female caller telephonically advised this office she did not want to get mixed up in anything, but that she had direct information that two persons were going to kill Senator KENNEDY sometime during his climb on Mount Kennedy.

Unsub. stated she knew the names of the people who were going to kill the Senator, but if she gave the names she would be directly involved in the matter and she didn't want any part of this deal.

Unsub. female was crying during the conversation and sounded like she honestly meant what she said. She did not sound as though she might be intoxicated. When asked for further details, she said she couldn't say any more, and thereupon, hung up.
