

On 12 December 1968, the Acting Executive Officer, Eastern Mindanao Region, this Bureau instructed the undersigned Agents to attend to the request of the Officer-in-Charge, Domestic Intelligence Division, this Bureau, contained in the herein attached radiophone message (innex "A").

It was reported that Subject, a citizen of Yemen entered the Philippines, in Olongapo City sometime in 1968. He was apprehended in Iligan City while waiting a plane for Cotabato City. When investigated, Subject could not produce any any papers and/or visa to enter the Philippines. It was further alleged in the said report that Subject could have something to do with the assassination of Sen. Robert Kennedy because Subject is a Yemenite and was also in California at the time of the said killing (Annex "B").

Investigation conducted by these Agents showed that Subject was born on 15 eptember 1933 at Hazar, Raden, Yemen, of ALI ACHMED NAMEH. He is married to FAYZIH SAIDI with whom he has two children. Subject's parents and wife are now deceased while his children are in the custody of his brother, MOHIMHAD ALI, who resides at 420 Tax, Yeman. Subject has also a sister by the name of FANDA ALI, who also resides at the above address.

It appears that Subject worked for a while with an American doctor, a certain Dr. Horn, at Bara, Arabia. It was this doctor who convinced

Subject to go to United States of America. On 26 March 1965, Subject immigrated to America. He entered New York City as an immigrant and was tenued Immigration Registration Certificate No. by the U.S. Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization Service (Annex "I"). Then he came to the United States, he was a holder of Passport

of the Republic of Arab of Yemen.

From New York City, Subjecttrensferred his residence to San Francisco, California. He was employed is a seamen with the Texco Shipping Company, making trips elong the eastern coast of United States, including the cities of San Francisco and Los ingeles, California and Scattle, Washington, as far as New Orlsan, Lupisiana. He He resigned from the said company and got an employment with the U.S. Merchant Marine Lines in San Francisco. He was a worker in the angine room of "SS Coscas Poch Three" of the said lines, bringing army supplies from United States to Victnam. Said ship passes by cither Olongapo City or Subject Bay, Philippings, for replanishment of oil and water supplies.

On 2 August 1965, said ship left San Francisco, California for her third trip to Vietnam. It arrived at Olongapo City on 23 August 1968 for provisions. Thile the said ship was docked at Olongapo City, Subject had a quarrel with some members of the craw. Subject was accused or suspected by the imerican crew members of the said ship of having something to do with the assassination of San. Robert Kannady because he is a Yemenite and a resident of San Francisco, California. The accused killerof Sen. Kennedy is also from Yemen. During the said incident, the chief cook and an oiler of the said ship tried to stab Subject with a knife. Subject, however, was able to parry the knife (Subject showed these Agents the scars on his fingers as the result of the reid thrust) and dove into the sea. He was later picked up by the Philippine Coast Guards and some Americans from Subjec Bay. He was given first aid treatment at the base hospital and later transferred to the redical Center in Manile for observation and further treetment.

Thile Subject was on a six-hour pass from the hospital allegedly to report to the Bureau of Inmigration, while, he met three unidentified Muslims who invited him for a drink in one of the bars. From there, the proceeded to a bar at the Manila Domestic Ariport where they continued drinking. Subject claimed that efter drinking with the Muslims, he felt dissy and later lost consciousness. According to Subject, when he wake up the following morning, he was already in litgan City.

From Ilijan City, Subject proceeded to Merzwi City. He stayed for three months at the house of a cartain Madji Mawi in Marawi City, While in Marawi 1 1 3 %

City, he was introduced by Hedji Alewi to the people of Marawi City and Malabang, Lanco del Sur, that he is a muslim priest. Decause Subject is not really a Muslim but a Jew, he did not like the idea and requested Hadji Alawi and even Commissioner Temano of the Bureau of National Integration to bring him to the American Embassy in Manile.

- When Subject insisted to go to Manila, he was maltreated by Muslims in Marawi City. On 10 December turned over to the PC authorities at 1968, he was Camp Evangelista, Cagayan de Oro City for interro-gation. Subject was later turned over to the Bureau of Immigration, Cagayan de Oro City for further disposition. Subject is now detained at the City Jail, Cagayan de Oro City.
- Several papers and documents were found in 10 the person of herein Subject (Annex "C"). These papers are now in the possession of the Bureau of Immigration Officer, Caseyan de Oro City for safe-keeping.
- Subject is an applicant for American Citisen-11 ship in San Francisco, California (Annex "D"). He is also a holder of a temporary driver's license in the state of California (Annex "E"). No cumind arest
- Subject's photograph and fingerprint chart are files hereto attached as innexes "F" and "G". 12 also hereto attached as innexes "F" and "G".
- His sworn statement dated 13 December 1968 olier fruits
 to these agents is also enclosed in 1968 olier fruits
 of (Annex 1981) 13 given to these agents is also enclosed in this report (Annex "H"). A personal letter written in Arabic, found in the possession of Subject is also attached in this report as Annex "J".
- Subject speaks and knows very little English. 14 There was a great difficulty in interrogating said Subject even with the help of a Lebanese interpreter. Subject expressed bitterness over the way he was treated by the local authorities and the Bureau of immigration officials. He claimed that he lost all his money (dollars and Philippine pesos) while he was deteined in Marawi City. He elso exhibited to these igents the wounds in-flicted on his head and face while he was under detention.
- While there is truth on the origin of herein 15 Subject and the circumstances surrounding his entry into the Philippines, these Agents expressed some doubts as to the real reason why and how he was brought to Lenao. There is no way, however, in establishing the real purpose why he came to Iligan City and stayed in Marawi City for three months without reporting to the proper authorities.

Subject: ALI ALI ACHNED SAID - page four -

As to the allegation that Subject has something to do with the assessination of Sen. Robert
Kennedy, there is no evidence gathered in the
course of investigation, to link Subject to the
said killing. This claim is only based on the
fact that Subject is a Yemenite and a resident
of San Francisco, California. But Subject in his
sworn statement given to these Agents claimed that
he was aboard a ship from Vietnam somewhere in
Panama during the time of said assessination. This
needs verification with the American authorities
to determine the veracity of this claim.

The personal letter written in Arabic found in the person of herein Subject should be submitted to translation to determine the contents of the same. This may be a good source of information regarding Subject.

Subject could not produce any paper to show that his entry into the Philippines is lawful. He is now in the custody of the Bureau of Immigration, Cageyan de Oro City for final disposition. In a conference with Atty. Celso Liloc, Bureau of Immigration Officer, Cageyan de Oro City, it was disclosed that he has orders from the Commissioner of the Bureau of Immigration, Manila to file corresponding charges against Subject for violation of Immigration Law, before the City Fiscal of Cage-yan de Oro City. This case would be the basis of eventual deportation of Subject from the Philippines.

CONCLUSION:

Subject has unlawfully entered the Philippines. There is no evidence, however, to link him in the assassination of Sen. Robert Kennedy.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, it is respectfully recommended that this report be forwarded to the Assistant Director, Domestic Intelligence Division, this Bureau for his information and further action; and that this case be considered closed and terminated as far as this Region is concerned.

REQUEST YOU FOLLOW UP WITH PC ARQUE OF CAMP EVANGELISTA, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY THE CASE OF ALI SAUDI YEMENITE, THO WAS BROUGHT TO Z-2, CAMP EVANGELISTA ON DECEMBER 10/68 MORNING FOR FURTHER INTERROGATION. SUBJECT IS GOING TO BE TURNED OVER BY PC TO THE IMMIGRATION OFFICER IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY THIS WEEKEND. FOLLOWING ARE FACTS ON CASE AS GATHERED BY OUR AGENTS IN ILIGAN CITY FROM INTERVIENS WITH LIMANG MANDANGAN OF LANAO SUR, PROVINCIAL COMMANDER GOLEZ AND ASSISTANT PROVINCIAL COMMANDER MAJOR GARCIA OF MARABI CITY, FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

THAT ON OR ABOUT THE MORNING OF DECEMBER 9/68 THILE IN ILICAN CITY AIRPORT FAITING FOR KLIGHT FOR COTABATO. SUBJECT'S PICTURE WAS TAKEN BY A PHOTOGRAPHER. SUBJECT GRAB-BED THE CAMERA AND DESTROYED THE FILM. THEN MANDANGAN ACOSTED HIM AND POUND THAT HE DID HOT HAVE ANY PASSPORT OR VISA. SUBJECT TAS BROUGHT TO MARANI CITY IN SS TAKEN DOWN BY THE PC THICH HE ANSTERED IN BROKEN ENGLISH. SUBJECT CLAIMED TO HAVE PAPERS SHOTING HE IS A CREY MEMBER OF U. S. HERCHAHT MARINE SHIP WHICH DOCKED IN OLONGAPO CITY ON AUGUST 1968. HE CAME FROM CALIFORNIA THERE HE HAS STATED FOR ABOUT THREE YEARS. THAT HE HAS POSSIBLE COM-PLICITY JITH THE ASSASSIBATION OF ROBERT KEN-HEDY WAS ONLY A THEORY OF CAPT. HANDAHGAN BASED ON THE FACT THAT SUBJECT WAS IN CALI-FORMIA IN TIME OF THE ASSASSINATION AND THAT ACCUSED MERG YEMBHITE. THIS THEORY IS NOT YET SUPPORTED BY ANY PACT.

CONFIDENTIAL SOURCES DISCLOSED THAT SUBJECT'S AR-RIVAL IN MARAVI CITY WAS PRECEZDED BY TELEGRAMS VIA CLAVECILIA PURPORTEDLY COMING FROM SOME COMMISSIONER ON NATIONAL INTEGRATION OFFICIALS IN MANILA THAT SUBJECT BE MET THILE IN MARAWI, SUBJECT WAS NOT IN ACTUAL PC CUSTODY BUT IN THE CUSTODY OF ONE EX-VICE GOVERNOR MESUG CALAGA OF LANAO SUR.

STORN STATEMENT OF ALI ALI ACHMED SAID GIVEN BEFORE NBI AGENTS EMERITO Z. GUTIERREZ AND AMBROSIO C. FET AT THE REGIONAL OFFICE, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY ON THIS 13TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1968.

1 - Question: Do you swear to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth in this investigation? Answer: Yes, sirs.

- · Q Please state your name, age, occupation and other personal circumstances.

 ALI ILI ACHMED SAID, born on 15 September 1933 at
 ANZAR, YEMEN, of ALI ACHMED NAMEH SAID, married to
 FAIZEH SAIDI, cleaner in the engine room of OSCAS F.T.
 U. S. Lines, San Francisco, California, United States
 of American 180 7th Street, Can Francisco, California, United States.
 - 3 Q With whom are you staying in San Francisco, California? A I am renting a room there but I do not have any companion because I only stay there for one, two or phree weeks and then sail in our ship.
 - 4 Q There are your parents now?

 A They are already dead. They died in Yemen, in my country.
 - 5 Q How about your wife, where is she now?
 - A Two children, HEZAM 12# years old and MAHALLIA 11# years and they are staying with my brother, MOHAMMAD ALI, in Yemen.
- 5 Q How about your wife, where is she now?

 1 FAYZEN SAIDI is also dead and she died three years ago.

 6 Q Do you have any children?

 1 Two children, HEZAM 12½ years old and MAHALLIA 11½ years and they are staying with my brother, MOHAMMAD ALI, in Iem.

 7 Q Do you have any brothers and sisters?

 1 One brother, MOHAMMAN ALI, who resides at 420 Tax, emen, and one sister, FANDA ALI who resides also in the same address.

 8 Q That is your citizenship?
 - 8 2 What is your citizenship?
 A I am still a citizen of Yemen, but I have already applied for American citizenship in California, U. S. A.
 - 9 2 When did you errived in the United States for the First time?

 A - March 26, 1965 I arrived in New York City. I was alone
 - that time.
 - 10 Q From New York, I went to San Francisco, California. A - I stayed in new York for about two weeks.
 - 11 Q There did you stay in New York? A - I stayed there in a hotel. I don't remember the hotel now.
 - 12 Q What was your reason for leaving Temen for United States?

 A When I was in BARA, in Arabia boy in an American in Arabia, Dr. John Horn and he was the one who convined me to go to America. Then I have enough; money after working, I took a plane from Baharain to New York City.
 - 13 Q -Where were working before you were employed with the U. S. Lines.?
 - A With Texco and as an ordinary seeman, we travel along the coast of United States in California, Los Angeles, San Francisco and Settle, Washington, U. S. A. Then when I

15 - Q - How rany times of trips have you taken from U. S. to Vietnam in your ship with the U. S. Lines?

- 16 Q Then was your last trip from U. S. to Vietnam?

 A We left San Francisco, U. S. last August 23, 1968, and we arrived at Olangapo City, Philippines on 23 August 1966. We were proceeding to Vietnem from Olangapo City, Philippines.
- 17 Q Thy did your ship stopped by Olangapo City last 23 August 1968?
 - A We stopped there for provisions like oil and water before proceeding to Vietnam.
- e That happened to you when you were in Olangapo City? 1 - I was with a crew member, the Chief Cook of our ship, and another oiler, I don't know the name also and they drank too much, and he tried to kill me with a knife, so I catched the knife with my hand and

1 - Three days. Ind after my discharge I went to Seam club. Then was the seaman's-Club, I met three whose names' I do not know, and they drank with me A - Filipino and American coast guards picked me up and they brought me to an American Doctor in Subic Bay and after treatment, they sent me to Medical

A - Three days. And after my discharge I went to Seaman's club. Then " was the seamen's-Club, I met three persons whose names' I do not know, and they drank with me.

21 - Q - That happened while you were drinking with the three persons you mentioned above?

A - After drinking with them, I did not feel well. I do
do not know what they put in my drink and I feel sick.
They they brought to the bar near the airport and drank some more. I just drank orange but I don't know what , they put inside and I lost my consciousness and I don't know what happened after that. I had one hundred dollars and two hundred pesos, I lost them and I don't know who took them.

22 - Q - From the bar near the airport, where did you go with the three persons?

A - Then I woke up, I was already in Ilizan City. While I was in Iligan, I stayed in the house of Hadji Alawi. He told me that he is the father of the governor. ESMAEL GINA told me to Commissioner Temano. I stayed in the house of Tamano. Commissioner Tamano told me that since I am a muslim, they will take care of me and they will help me. But I want to go to Manila and see the American Embassy. But Commissioner Tamano tried to convine me to stay with the muslim and they will helped me. Then he left SWORN STATEMENT OF ALL ALL ACHMED SAID - page three -

for Manila and them when he came back, he told to stay in Marawi City, but I told him I want to go to Manila and he tried to convince me again until he left again for Manila and promised to come back on January. I told him that the people in Marawi City do not like because they think, I am an American Jew and I am and American FBI and they thought that United States sent me to spy on them. Ind whenever I want to eat in a Christian place or restaurant to eat, there were always armed man with me. This is so because I am Jew, according to them.

- 23 Q "Wed there any unsual incident which kappened to you while you were in Marawi City?
 - A One time, ALAWI sent somebody to me to the house, I stayed in his house three days. While there, I met two persons, one from SAUDI ARABIA and other is from Egypt. ALAWI told me that if I have money, I can go with these persons to Egypt, but I told him I went to go to America and not to Egypt. When I told him that, they got angry and they suspected me to be a Hew, so they maltreated me and turned over the the police.
- 24 Q Why do you not went to be with the muslims in Marawi City?
 - A Because I am a Jew and if they will know that I am a Jew they will surely kill me there. And will not let anybody know this.
- 25 Q Do you know the name of the person from Egypt and that person from Saudi Arabia?
 - A I don't know them.
- 26 Q Thatwere they there?
 - I Because ALAWI called for them to determine or to esceptain if I am really a Muslim but they found out that I am a Jew so they hated me. As a matter of fact, they wanted or planned to kill me.
- 27 Q Do you have any identification papers or other documents to prove your identity and citizen?

 A They were taken by a the P.C. in Havani City.
- 28 Q Is it true that you destroyed a cemera while you were bound for Cotabato while you were in Iligan City?
 - A No, sirs. I only tore the film of the camera because
 I don't like my-picture taken. According to the person
 from Egypt, he going to take my picture and send it to
 Egypt and I don't like that, so I tore the film with
 my picture.
- 29 Q Do you know who maltreated you in marawi City?

 1 Capt Mandangan hit me with firearm and only the CHristians who save me there.
- 30 Q There were you when Robert Kennedy was killed? A - I was in my boat somewhere in Panama Canal.
- 31 Q Do you kno w the person who killed dobert Kennedy? A I don't know, sirs.
- 32 Q Did you quarrel with the Chief Cook and the otler in your boat? BEZZZZZ
 - A Because they accused me that I am countryman who killed Robert Kennedy and I got mad and they tried to kill so I have to jump to the see. As a matter of fact, I have still the scars Qbomble shape when I catched the knife with which they tried to kill me

- 33 Q Do you know why was the reason why the muslim brought to Lanco?
 - A Because they think I am a muslim and I could be of help to their religion. This is what I think why they brought me to Lanco.
- 34 ? Q There do you went to go home, in Temen or California?

 I Iwant to be in California. I don't want to back to Yemen.
- 35 Q Aside from Ilijan and Marawi City, what places in Philippines have you been?
 - 4 Iligan and Marawi City and Malabang and Manile?
- 36 Q Why did you go to Malabang?
 - A I was in roduced as a Arabian and a muslim and the people gave them money. I was Alavi and two others that time.
- 37 What is the reason why you don't want you picture taken?

 A Because the picture was taken by Egypt and they will send the picture to the Egyptian Ambassador and they will report me the the police.
- 38 2 That is the purpose why you were brought to Lanco?
 A As I told you before, I think they want me to be a priest and than introduce me to the people and ask money to help me. This is what I think they needed me. As a matter of fact, they bought some fuelim things for my use.

Muslim things for my use.

39 - - That is your educational attainment?

- A I did not study, but I learned English thru experience in the ship where I was working.
- 40 4 Did you tell us all the truth? A - Yes, sirs.
- 41 Q Did you receive or send any telegram while you were in Iligan or Marawi City?
 - A Sent telegrams several times but I never received eny answer. And where there were enswers by the American Embassy but they tore the answer but they did not inform of any answer. I addressed the telegrams to the American Embassy in Manila. asking help to get me out of Maravi City.
- 42 Q Do you have any other name other than the ALI ACHMED SAID?
 - A KNNOR I om el eys known as ALI ALI COUNED SAID.
- 43 4 Did understand this statement?
 1 Les, sirs.
- 44 2 Are you willing to sign this statements of le




