
Dear Mr. Turner

Thought perhaps I should write and let you know that I received Mr. Charles E. Savage's letter of 22 August 1978. Please inform him that he need not wait for any further correspondence from me.

Apparently you have not received all of my correspondence and I would like verymuch to findout why you have not. Therefore I am not going to send you anymore correspondence Mr. Turner, what I suggest that you do is send a top agent to have a personal talk with me out here in California, what I suggest that you do is send somebody you can trust to keep his mouth shut about what I tell him because I do not want some government officials here in California finding out I turned some information over to Congressman Louis Stokes who is the chairman of the House Slect Committee on Assassinations. I am a man who was approached four different times by somebody in 1962 to make a "HIT" on Robert F. Kennedy and I would like to straighten out the investigators who are working on the Kennedy assassinations for the House Slect Committee on Assassinations. I suggest that you contact Congressman Louis Stokes, Seantor Alan Cranston, and Senator Edward Kennedy in regard to what I have just written. I want to findout if they are going to make the confidential arrangements I asked for. I want to findout if they are going to follow my suggestions...

Thank you for your personal attention regarding this letter. If you have any doubts about my being approached by somebody who asked me if I would accept a contact to "HIT" Robert F. Kennedy, then you have my permission to give me a Lie-Detector-Poly-Graph-Test and if necessary Sodium-Pentothal to findout whether or not I am telling a lie or the truth. Your move Mr. Turner, and please convey a message to President Cater for me, tell him Raymond Lucky Treloar says that he is still trying to get top government officials of their asses.
