2. Did anyone with CIA connections work on the <sup>LA police</sup> investigation of the assassination of Robert Kennedy. (Specifically did Sgt. Enrique (Hank) <sup>(En-reekay)</sup> Hernandez or Lt. Manuel Pena ever work for any agency connected with the CIA) ?
