GEORGE F.A. BOIAN, 300 East 91st Street, NYC, an individual who has furnished reliable and unreliable information in the past, advised SA JOHN J. CRONIN on 2/24/70, that he learned from GHEORGHE BUZDUGAN on 2/23/70, that BUZDUGAN was imprisoned in Romania from 1945 to 1964, inasmuch as he was the son of GORDIS (PH), a Romanian Government leader in 1918. BUZDUGAN also claimed that he was imprisoned in the Soviet Union for five years.

BUZDUGAN advised that he had received a \$10,000 check from the late NY Senator, ROBERT F. KENNEDY, a short time before his death, for documents he made available to KENNEDY. The day following KENNEDY's death, BUZDUGAN attempted to cash KENNEDY's check in Paris, France, but the banks refused to honor the check. He went to the American Embassy in Paris and he was told by Ambassador SARGENT SHRIVER to wait until KENNEDY's affairs were put in order in Washington, D.C.

BUZDUGAN advised BOIAN that on 12/7/69, his property, which consisted of the \$10,000 check, a suit, watch, and presents for the KENNEDY's children, disappeared at the Port Authority, NYC. He reported the loss to the Port Authority Police. BUZDUGAN requested that BOIAN accompany him to the Port Authority Police to ascertain if they have obtained any information regarding his lost property. They were to proceed to the Port Authority Police on 2/24/70, but BUZDUGAN called a lawyer in Washington, D.C., who advised him to come to Washington. The lawyer is a friend of BUZDUGAN from Arad, Romania. BOIAN stated that BUZDUGAN may see Senator EDWARD KENNEDY to discuss his problem.

In conversations with BOIAN, it is noted that he continuously rambles from subject to subject, seemingly never coming to a conclusion on any particular subject. The NYO feels that he is mentally unbalanced and sources have described him as being a "nut" and unstable. His file reflects that he received a medical discharge from the U.S. Army because of a nervous breakdown. Due to the above, and due to the fact that BOIAN continuously makes statements that cannot be substantiated, the NYO is setting out the above for information and is not setting out the information in a form suitable for dissemination.

Indices of the NYO reflect that in a "New York Times" article dated 8/21/69, Page 12, that one GHEORGHE BUZDUGAN was named president of the National Council for Scientific Research by the Romanian Government.

BUZDUGAN was not available for interview inasmuch as he had already departed for Washington.

In view of the source of information in this case, the NYO feels that the following steps should be taken.





Mr. GEORGE CECIL THOMPSON telephonically contacted the SAC's Office on 12/2/72 and said that he had information concerning SIRHAN B. SIRHAN and would talk to no one but Mr. JAMIESON. The writer telephonically contacted Mr. THOMPSON at telephone number 241-6035 which is listed to his residence at 1528 Ia Canada Ave., Glendale, California. Mr. THOMPSON has been in contact with this office on 6/10/70 (56-156-2950) at which time he claimed to have evidence that SIRHAN was innocent, and that he had presented the defense and the prosecution with this evidence. He also is mentioned in 56-156-3104, which the Chief Clerk's Office was unable to locate.

Mr. THOMPSON advised the writer that he has read the transcript and the medical reports and in his opinion SIRHAN is innocent. I inquired of Mr. THOMPSON as to whether or not he had made this information available to the Los Angeles Police Department as they were the investigating agency in this case and he said that he had and that they gave him the brush off. He has also presented it to the District Attorney who has also given him the brush off. He advised that the defense had sent a private investigator by the name of MIKE MC GOWAN and had not paid any attention to his conclusions. He contended that this was a violation of SIRHAN's civil rights.

It was pointed out to him that this case had been adjudicated through the California Supreme Court, had several hearings regarding the evidence subsequent to the trial. THOMPSON advised that he had called the USA's Office regarding his claim of civil rights and they told him to contact the FBI. Mr. THOMPSON was advised that he should put all of his data into written form in a clear and concise manner into what areas he felt SIRHAN's civil rights had been violated and that the matter would be referred to the Department of Justice for adjudication,

The article relates that Los Angeles Attorney GODFREY ISSAC filed a complaint against the Los Angeles Folice Department (LAPD) and Los Angeles District Attorney's Office on behalf of his client, THEOLOBE CHARACH. The complaint charges defendents, individual members of the LAPD and District Attorney's Office with supressing facts and evidence relating to the assassination of ROBERT F. KENNEDY. CHARACH later withdrew his complaint to allow the defendent and news media to answer all of CHARACH's framings regarding this matter.

A Letterhead Memorandum (LHM) captioned THEODORE CHARACH furnishing his background was forwarded to the Bureau as an enclosure to Los Angeles Airtel to the Bureau dated 3/29/67, captioned "THEODORE CHARACH, FOREIGN POLICE COOPERATION, BUFILE: 163-17948, LOS ANGELES FILE: 163-1102.

The "Free Press" article makes reference to a guard named THANE CESER, who was on duty at the Ambassador Hotel the night that KENNEDY was assassinated. Interview of THANE CESER regarding KENSALT investigation appears on page 75 of Los Angeles KENSALT report dated 6/15/68. CHARACH's name was included in LEV sent as enclosure to Los Angeles teletype to the Bureau dated 12/3/68, captioned KENSALT, LHM captioned "Contemplated List of Witnesses for the Trial of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN" lists potential witnesses listed by Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

"Free Press" also makes reference to a <u>DONALD</u> SCHULMAN, KNXT employee, allegedly at Ambassador Hotel on the night of the assassination.

ROLAND SANCHEZ, Los Angeles Towing Service, 1819 South Oak Street, Los Angeles, telephone 749-0187, advised that he repossessed an automobile for GMAC during the early morning hours of 6/19/70 which was a 1966 Cadillac, bearing California license TVR 943. This automobile is registered to BERT J. WARHEN, 1662 West Second Street, Los Angeles.

SANCHEZ advised that while cleaning out the automobile, he found a newspaper in the trunk of the car concerning the shooting of BOBBY KENNEDY. This struck him as highly unusual inasmuch as KENNEDY was killed along time ago and he was unable to understand why someone would become attached to a newspaper article relating to a story as far back as the shooting of Senator KENNEDY. Mr. SANCHEZ merely wanted to bring this matter to the attention of the FBI.

Los Angeles indices show references to BERT ESTES WARREN and BERTRAM FRANCIS WARREN in 26, 76, an 88 classifications; however, they do not appear to be identical to the WARREN mentioned herein. The license number on the vehicle is negative.

On 7/20/70 MRS. ROSE LYN MASSEY was telephonically contacted and her telephone call to this office on 7/18/70 was acknowleged.

It was explained to MRS. MASSEY that SIRHAN had been tried in a state court and that his case was under appeal to a higher state court. She was advised further that if she or MRS. SIRHAN had anyinformation that it would be more appropriate to furnish this information to the Los Angeles Police Department or to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

MRS. MASSEY made reference to the information brought forth by THEODORE CHARACK and it was explained to her that if CHARACK had information bearing on the trial or convivtion of SIRHAN that he should bring this to the office of the District Attorney or to the courts through the proper legal channels.

MRS. MASSEY seemed satisfied with the explanation and stated that her only concern was for the welfare of MRS. SIRHAN as she felt that MARY SIRHAN had been taken advantage of by many of the individuals associated with the case and the trial.


ADEL BISHARA SIRHAN, INTERNAL SECURITY - MIDDLE EAST.

ON NINE NINE SEVENTY, AT EIGHT AM, MARSHALL BAKER, SALES REPRESENTATIVE, INTERNATIONAL HOTEL, JFK AIRPORT, ADVISED THAT LUKE MC KISSICK MADE ARRANGEMENTS FOR A PRESS CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT THE INTERNATIONAL HOTEL FROM TEN AM TO ELEVEN AM ON NINE NINE SEVENTY. THIRTY MEMBERS OF THE PRESS WERE ANTICIPATED BY MC KISSICK. WING ROOM A WAS DESIGNATED BY BAKER FOR THE CONFERENCE.

MC KISSICK, MC COWAN, MRS. SIRHAN AND ADEL SIRHAN ARRIVED AT PRESS CONFERENCE AT TEN ZERO EIGHT AM.

ABOUT FORTY MEMBERS OF THE PRESS ARE PRESENT.

MC KISSICK OPENED UP THE CONFERENCE ABOUT TEN TEN
AM STATING HE IS THE SPOKESMAN FOR MARY B. SIRHAN AND
THE SIRHAN FAMILY. THE BASIC REASON THAT THEY WANTED TO GO
WAS TO "SAVE LIVES", THEY WISH TO PERSUADE ARAB GUERRILLAS THAT
THE TAKING OF HUMAN LIVES IS NOT BENEFICIAL TO ANYONE.

MCKISSICK ADVISED THAT DESPITE REPEATED ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT FRED B. SMITH, THE GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE WHO CANCELLED HIS PASSPORT, HE HAS NOT BEEN SUCCESSFUL.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION PUT FORTH BY A NEWS REPORTER CONCERNING WHETHER OR NOT THE PURPOSE OF MRS. SIRHAN'S TRIP TO THE MIDDLE EAST WAS TO TRADE HER SON'S LIFE FOR THE LIVES OF THE HOSTAGES, MRS. SIRHAN REPLIED THAT THIS WAS NOT TRUE, THAT ALL HUMAN LIFE IS PRECIOUS TO HER. REPORTERS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE CONFENCE HAVE ASKED SEVERAL TIMES ABOUT THE EXACT PURPOSE OF THE SIRHAN FAMILY TRIP TO THE MIDDLE EAST AND EACH TIME THEY HAVE BEEN ADVISED BY MR. MC KISSICK THAT THE SOLE PURPOSE OF THEIR TRIP WAS TO SAVE THE LIVES OF THE HOSTAGES. MR. MC KISSICK POINTED OUT THAT ONE OF THE KEY FACTORS WAS THE TIME ELEMENT.

AT THE OPENING OF THE PRESS CONFERENCE, LUKE

MC KISSICK EXPRESSED DISAPPOINTMENT AT THE PRESS COVERAGE

HE HAD RECEIVED ON HIS PREVIOUS PRESS CONFERENCE ON NINE

EIGHT SEVENTY. HE STATED THAT HE WAS DISAPPOINTED AT

SECRETARY OF STATE ROGER'S COMMENT CONCERNING THE

EFFORTS OF THE UNITED STATES TO SECURE THE RELEASE

OF HOSTAGES IN JORDAN. HE STATED THAT HIS AND MRS.

SIRHAN'S PRIME CONSIDERATION IN THEIR EFFORTS IS TO

SAVE LIVES.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION CONCERNING WHY THE ARABS SHOULD LISTEN TO MRS. SIRHAN, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE BELIEVES THAT SHE COULD BE PERSUASIVE WITH THEM. HE ADDED THAT HE DOES NOT KNOW IF THE RELEASE OF SIRHAN B. SIRHAN IS PRESENTLY ON THE LIST OF DEMANDS BEING MADE BY THE ARABS. HE DOES KNOW THAT IT WAS AT ONE TIME A DEMAND, BUT HE DOES NOT KNOWN IF IT CONTINUES TO BE ONE. HE AGAIN STATED THAT SIRHAN SIRHAN IS A HERO IN THE ARAB WORLD AND THAT MRS. SIRHAN WOULD BE LISTENED TO FOR THAT REASON AND WOULD BE ABLE TO SPEAK OUT AGAINST VIOLENCE.

MC KISSICK THEN STATED IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION
THAT MRS. SIRHAN HAS A VALID JORDANIAN PASSPORT,
BUT IS BEING PROHIBITED FROM LEAVING THE UNITED STATES
BY GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY.

IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION CONCERNING WHY THE ARAB GUERRILLAS ARE HOLDING HOSTAGES, MRS. SIRHAN ANSWERED THAT THEY ARE PERSECUTED PEOPLE, THAT THEIR LIVES ARE LESS THAN HUMAN AND THAT THEY ARE FORCED TO TAKE THESE MEASURES EVEN IF THEY DO NOT WISH TO DO SO.

WHEN ASKED WHY THE ARAB GUERRILLAS WOULD REQUEST THE RELEASE OF SIRHAN SIRHAN, MRS. SIRHAN ANSWERED THAT HE IS A PALESTINIAN. SHE DID NOT ELABORATE.

IN RESPONSE TO THE QUESTION IS THERE ANY OTHER REASON WHY THE PASSPORTS OF THE PARTY WERE REVOKED, MC KISSICK ANSWERED THAT IT WAS HIS OPINION THAT MRS. SIRHAN MIGHT "UP-STAGE" THE STATE DEPARTMENT IN THE INTERNATIONAL SCENE AND THAT THE EGO OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS MIGHT BE HURT. HE CONTINUED THAT MRS. SIRHAN AND HE WOULD HAVE NO PROBLEM TALKING TO THE GUERRILLAS, WHERE THE STATE DEPARTMENT APPEARS TO HAVE PROBLEMS IN THIS DIRECTION.

HE STATED THAT IF THIS IS THE REASONING OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT IT IS NOT LEGITIMATE.

MC KISSICK STATED HE DOES NOT INTEND TO ENTER
NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE US STATE DEPARTMENT CONCERNING
THE RESTORING OF HIS PASSPORT SINCE HE BELIEVES SUCH
NEGOTIATIONS WOULD BE FRUITLESS.

MC KISSICK THEN ALUDED TO FRED SMITH, THE STATE

DEPARTMENT OFFICIAL UPON WHOSE AUTHORITY HIS AND MICHAEL

COWAN'S PASSPORTS WERE REVOKED. HE STATED THAT THE

STATE DEPARTMENT IS IN HIDING, AND THAT HE WAS UNABLE

TO REACH SMITH OR ANY OTHER RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL BY

TELEPHONE AT THE TIME OF THE PASSPORT REVOCATION.

HE WISHES TO DEBATE SMITH OR ANOTHER OFFICIAL IN A

PUBLIC FORUM.

CONCERNING HIS PRESENT PLANS, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE, MC COWAN AND THE SIRHANS PLAN TO STAY IN NEW YORK THIS EVENING. THEY HOPE TO GET ON A TV TALK SHOW IN ORDER TO EXPRESS THEIR OPINIONS FREELY WITHOUT THE PRESSURE OF A PRESS CONFERENCE. MC KISSICK OPENLY INVITED STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS TO BE PRESENT TO GET THEIR SIDE BUT COMMENTED THAT HE DOUBTED THAT THEY WOULD ACCEPT HIS INVITATION. HE COMMENTED THAT HE HAS NOT BEEN INVITED TO APPEAR ON ANY TV SHOW AS YET BUT POINTED OUT THAT HE HAS BEEN IN VIRTUAL SECLUSION SINCE ARRIVING IN NEW YORK.

MC KISSICK INDICATED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT HAD REVOKED HIS PASSPORT BY POWER AND NOT BY RIGHT DESPITE THE CURRENT USAGE OF THE THEME OF LAW AND ORDER. HE STATED THAT THE "ONUS" IS ON THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHOULD LIVES BE LOST. AN AMERICAN LADEY IN LOS ANGELES CALLED MRS. SIRHAN AND OFFERED TO PAY MRS. SIRHAN'S FARE. MC KISSICK DID NOT FURTHER ELABORATE ON THIS STATEMENT. HE FURTHER INDICATED, HOWEVER, THAT CERTAIN NEWS MEDIA IN LOS ANGELES HAD TOLD HIM THAT THEY WOULD BE INTERESTED IN FINANCING MRS. SIRHAN'S TRIP TO THE MIDDLE EAST.

MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE HAS TRIED REPEATEDLY TO CONTACT MR. GEORGE SHIBLEY (PHONETIC) IN BEIRUT WITHOUT SUCCESS. MRS. SIRHAN WAS AGAIN ASKED IF IN FACT THE PURPOSE OF HER TRIP WAS NOT TO OBTAIN AMNESTY FOR HOR SON. MRS. SIRHAN INDICATED THAT ANY MOTHER IN HER POSITION WOULD WANT TO GAIN FREEDOM FOR HER SON.

WHEN ASKED BY THE NEWS MEDIA IF SHE BELIEVED THE GUERRILLAS WOULD KILL THE HOSTAGES, SHE REPLIED, "I AM SORRY, I HOPE NOT."

NEWS MEDIA ASKED MR. MC KISSICK IF HE OR THE SIRHAN FAMILY HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH ANY OF THE FAMILIES OF THE HOSTAGES. HE REPLIED THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO COMMUNICATION ON THAT LEVEL.

WHEN MC KISSICK WAS ASKED IF HE OR THE SIRHAN FAMILY
HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH THE ARAB GUERRILLAS, HE ADVISED THAT
THE SIRHAN FAMILY IN JORDAN HAD FRIENDS AMONG THE
GUERRILLAS.

CONCERNING THE FINANCING OF THE TRIP, MC KISSICK STATED THAT HE IS FINANCING HIS OWN TRAVEL, THAT THE SIRHANS ARE TRAVELING ON HIS CREDIT CARD. HE HAS HOPES OF SOLICITING THE AID OF THE BRAODCASTING NETWORKS IN HOPES THAT THEY WILL SUBSIDIZE THIS TRAVEL IN RETURN FOR FIRST HAND COVERAGE.

MC KISSICK STATED THAT HIS PARTY WAS "YANKED" INTO A ROOM AT THE AIRPORT YESTERDAY AND THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT IS KEEPING MRS. SIRHAN FROM JORDAN "BY POWER, NOT BY RIGHT". HE STATED AS HER ATTORNEY, HE HAS COUNSELED HER NOT TO GO TO JORDAN BECAUSE SHE MIGHT BE DENIED THE RIGHT TO RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES, SINCE SHE IS NOT A CITIZEN.

MC KISSICK STATED THAT THE GUERRILLAS WILL
PROBABLY NOT BOW TO THE POWER OF THE UNITED STATES, BECAUSE
THEIR EGO MIGHT BE SHATTERED, BUT THAT THEY MIGHT LISTEN
TO THE APPEAL OF MRS. SIRHAN.
