Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2007-0002-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA.

The photographs dated January 20th through January 31st, 1993 processed for this request depict the following events: Presidential Inaugural activities, Vice President Gore's swearing-in ceremony as President of the Senate, Open House at the White House, tours of the West Wing and Old Executive Office Building for President William J. Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., press conferences, executive signings, traveling on Marine Two, the Cabinet swearing-in "grip and grins" and reception, Vice President Gore's interview with NBC Nightly News, Madeline Albright's swearing-in as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations, Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall's funeral, a Democratic Caucus conference, meeting of the Senate Armed Services Committee, Vice President Gore's meeting with the Prime Minister of Norway Harlem Brundtland, Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore meeting with her Chief of Staff Skila Harris, Vice President Gore's conference call with President Clinton about family medical leave, and the receiving lines and performances for the National Governors' Association Dinner.

Photographs dated January 1st through January 20th, 2001 processed for this request depict the following events: Vice President Gore swearing in new U.S. Senators including Hilary Clinton as U.S. Senator from New York, a Vice President Gore speech at the Library of Congress, a Senator Lieberman Senate Office party; greetings and drop-bys to various Vice Presidential staff offices, Vice President Gore's certification of the 2000 presidential election results and the procession of the electoral box from the Senate to the House, a "Tribute to the Clintons" party at the White House with a performance by Fleetwood Mac a second swearing in ceremony for Hilary Clinton at Madison Square Garden which included a performance by Billy Joel, an AFL/CIO lunch honoring Vice President Gore, ceremonies and receiving lines with Vice President Gore's national security staff, a thank you gathering for Vice Presidential staff, Vice President Gore signing the Vice Presidential desk, posed photographs with Vice President Gore and Oval Office staff, and Vice President Gore and his staff on Air Force Two.

Photographers of these images were Callie Shell, Vince Musi, and Molly Bingham.

System of Arrangement

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in the following collection: Vice Presidential Records of the White House Photograph Office.

The White House Photograph Office assigned each roll of 35 mm film a unique roll number. The roll numbers for the Vice Presidential photographs begin with "V" in order to distinguish them from the Presidential photographs taken by White House photographers during the administration. The office created a contact sheet for each roll of film and organized them in binders by film type (color or black and white) and roll number. The contact sheets responsive to this request are arranged by binder book number, and thereunder, by roll number. The Photograph Office left gaps in the roll numbers for unexplained reasons.

Archival processing is done at the contact sheet level.
