**Extent**

Three folders, approximately 160 pages

**Access**

## **Scope and Content**

The materials in this series are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of FOIA request 2014-0029-F.

This series contains records related to Vice President Al Gore meeting with the United States members of the Gore Chernomyrdin Commission on September 24, 1993 and a meeting with United States business leaders at a Gore Chernomyrdin Commission session on September 1, 1993. This series consists of memoranda, talking points, list of committee members, appointment request documents, and form letters. The inclusive date range for this series of records is 1993 to 1995 with the bulk of the materials from 1993.

Due to national security restrictions, more than half of this collection remains closed including memoranda of conversation, talking points, and summaries from events other than the aforementioned meetings.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in Gore Vice Presidential Records: White House Staff Member and Office Files.

Staff Member and Office Files are the textual records created and/or maintained by White House staff members within their individual offices. These files document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member and Office Files are processed at the folder level, and the documents within are maintained in their original order. Since the files are processed at the folder level, individual documents contained within these folders may not be wholly responsive to the subject area of this FOIA request.
