Scope and Content

The materials in this series are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of FOIA case 2022-0038-F.

This series of photographs include sixteen photographs of a bilateral meeting of Vice President Biden with Prime Minister Aleksander Vucic at the Serbian Palace in Belgrade on August 16, 2016, seven photographs of Vice President Biden with his staff reviewing his remarks in a holding room at the Serbian Palace on August 16, 2016, eight photographs of Vice President Biden with Serbian President Tomislav Nikolic while the United States and Serbian delegations gather in the background, nine photographs of the bilateral meeting of Vice President Biden with President Tomislav Nikolic at the Serbian Palace on August 16, 2016 and eighteen photographs of Vice President Biden with his staff preparing for a joint press statement at the Assembly Building in Pristina, Kosovo on August 17, 2016.

Other Serbian government officials depicted in these photos include First Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia Ivica Dacic, Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia Zorana Mihajlovic, Serbian Minister of Internal Affairs Nebojsa Stefanovic, Serbian Minister of Defense Zoran Djordjevic, Serbian Director of Office for Kosovo and Metohija Marko Djuric, Ambassador Ivan Mrkic, Predrag Mikic, Stanislava Pak Stankovic, Aleksandar Crevar, Smiljana Cujic. and Tatjana Jovic. White House staff depicted at these events include National Security Advisor to the Vice President Colin Kahl, Special Assistant to the President and National Security Council Senior Director for European Affairs Charlie Kupchan, Special Policy Advisor for Europe and Eurasia to Vice President Biden Anna Makanju, National Security Council Director for Balkans, Caucasus, and Central European Affairs Mark Tervakoski, Special Advisor for Europe and Russia to the Vice President Cherrie Daniels, Meghan Goodman and Carlyn Reichel. Other United States government officials depicted in these photographs include United States Ambassador to Serbia Kyle Scott and United States Ambassador to Kosovo Greg Delawie.

System of Arrangement

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in the Vice Presidential images collection from the White House Photo Office. These records are maintained in the Executive Office of the President instance of the Electronic Records Archive (EOP ERA) which contains electronic records created or received by the administration of President Barack Obama.

The White House Photo Office assigned each image a unique number based on its digital set and frame numbers. Identifying numbers for the Vice Presidential photographs begin with "V" to distinguish them from the Presidential photographs taken by White House photographers.

Images are reviewed and released at the item level in contrast with textual records which are reviewed at the folder level.

The responsive images retrieved from EOP ERA are saved in search results lists (SRLs) within the system. The following is a list of the SRLs saved and processed in response to FOIA 2022-0038-F:
