Scope and Content

The materials in this series are selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of FOIA case 2022-0120-F. The researcher submitted a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records for Biden Vice Presidential records concerning White House visits and official travel with his son Hunter Biden and brother James (Jim) Biden and narrowed their request to specific terms.

This series includes 3 email messages dated April 13, 2016 between Fran Person and Eric Schwerin, with Hunter Biden carbon copied, regarding a White House tour.

Also included are 78 email messages to and from James Biden, Sara Biden, Michelle Smith, Jillian Doody, Nancy Orloff, Kellen Suber, Fran Person, Anne Marie Muldoon, Marcos Ibarra, Carlos Elizondo, Rob Horowitz, Kathy Chung, Jose Miguel Aleman, Juan Verde, and Jennifer Carton. The emails date between May 26, 2009 and December 5, 2016, and relate to arranging tours of the White House, United States Capitol, and Naval Observatory for contacts of James and Sara Biden.

System of Arrangement

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in the Biden Vice Presidential Electronic Records collection which includes email messages and electronic files. These records are maintained in the Executive Office of the President instance of the Electronic Records Archive (EOP ERA) which contains electronic records created or received by the administration of President Barack Obama. These electronic records are born-digital files and are primarily .eml, .pdf, .wpd, and .doc files.

The responsive electronic records retrieved from EOP ERA are saved in search results lists (SRLs) and are arranged chronologically by creation date. The following is a list of the SRLs saved and processed in response to FOIA 2022-120-F[6]:
