Scope and Content

This series consists of photographs of President Jimmy Carter attending various events during the Obama administration. Most of the photographs are from the funeral service for Joan Mondale, held at the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Minneapolis on February 8, 2014. There are also photographs of President Carter attending the China State Dinner reception in the East Room of the White House for Chinese President Hu Jintao on January 19, 2011. The remaining photographs include: President Carter's participation in the Let Freedom Ring ceremony to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s "I Have a Dream" speech, held on August 28, 2013 at the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, D.C.; a photograph of President Carter at the U.S. Capitol following the January 21, 2013 inauguration ceremony; and President Carter greeting Vice President Biden and Vice President Walter Mondale at the Four Seasons Hotel prior to the "Celebrating Fritz: An Evening with Walter Mondale" Gala dinner in Washington, D.C. on October 22, 2015.

Roslyn Carter, President Barack Obama, Michelle Obama, Vice President Biden, Dr. Jill Biden, President William J. Clinton, Secretary Clinton, Chinese President Hu Jintao, Vice President Mondale, Ted Mondale, William Mondale, and other members of the Mondale family are depicted in these photographs with President Carter.

These photographs were taken by David Lienemann, Chuck Kennedy, and Lawrence Jackson.

System of Arrangement

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in the Vice Presidential images collection from the White House Photo Office. These records are maintained in the Executive Office of the President instance of the Electronic Records Archive (EOP ERA) which contains electronic records created or received by the administration of President Barack Obama.

The White House Photo Office assigned each image a unique number based on its digital set and frame number. Identifying numbers for the Vice Presidential photographs begin with "V" to distinguish them from the Presidential photographs taken by White House photographers.

Images are reviewed and released at the item level in contrast with textual records which are reviewed at the folder level.

The responsive images retrieved from EOP ERA are saved in search results lists (SRLs) within the system. The following is a list of the SRLs saved and processed:
