


# Why I built FOIA Mapper

A searchable database of FOIA logs




## Who uses FOIA and why?

An analysis of 229,000 requests from 85 federal agencies




- Includes only agencies who report both the name and the organization of the requester.
- The span of time covered by the data varies by agency, with an average time period of 3 years.

## Breakdown by Agency




### Frequent Filers: Businesses

Five little-known financial research companies dominate




### Frequent Filers: News Media

The most frequent requesters are large, mainstream news outlets




# Frequent Filers: Political & Nonprofit

## FOIA Log Considerations

# FOIA logs can be a huge time saver for both the requester and the agency

#### The importance of format

Best case: Excel/CSV

Almost as good: Structured PDF

Hard to work with: Scanned PDF

Painful: Printed hardcopy

Frequent updates are ideal, but older FOIA logs are still very helpful
