Consistent with your new records determination authority in the new amendments to the Federal Records Act, the Department of State has asked NARA to review the personal (non-Federal) emails from former Secretary Clinton that were included in the transfer of the Federal records from her personal server.

The Department of State would like us to review the personal emails, and then confirm State's determinations prior to State returning the personal materials to Mrs. Clinton.

I recommend we undertake this review.
