Thanks for your message and my apologies for not sending these materials to you directly earlier. We were so focused on carrying out the Archivist's SAO meeting on Monday, April 6th at the McGowan that I lost track of getting back to you on this. Again, my apologies.

Attached is the April 2nd response and nine attachments from State regarding my March 3rd letter. Because of the press questions about whether or not we received a response -- and what it says/said - we posted this press release on April 9th.

We are still in the process of evaluating the materials they've submitted. It's not completely responsive to our standard questions, so we are devising a strategy for how to proceed.

We also expect to meet with State officials on how plan to proceed later this upcoming week (April 23 or 24). I met at the staff level last Friday, April 17th on a records review issue related to these materials.
