October 19-November 10, 1982

This schedule is designed for the use and information of the traveling party and other U.S. officials assisting with the Attorney General's trip. Because confirmed appointments will sometimes not be finalized until as late as the day before they occur, and for security reasons, this schedule should be treated confidentially. The original version of this schedule will be based in part on supposition and guesswork and will include a number of entries not yet confirmed by host governments. Subsequent revisions will provide further details and will attempt to include all necessary logistical and protocol information.

Be sure to check the Control Room/Staff Office established in each hotel for the latest schedule information at least daily. While complete schedules for each country will be provided upon departure from the previous country or upon arrival in a new country, there are likely to be daily changes that may very well impact on travel times and meeting participants.

When you are scheduled to accompany the Attorney General (generally including the entire party on travel days), plan to be in place and ready to depart at least 10 minutes prior to scheduled departure.

Baggage deadlines are firm and final. Baggage must be turned in at the Control Room/Staff Office no later than the time indicated; on arrival, baggage will be available at the Control Room/Staff Office 30-60 minutes after your arrival at the hotel in each city. The Control Room/Staff Office will also be the place at which one obtains one's hotel room key (you will have been pre-registered). Because hotel rooms will be direct-billed to your agency, it is imperative that you pay any incidental charges (laundry, cleaning, room service, bar, restaurant, phone calls, etc.) before departing the hotel.

The mode of transportation for the trip is a U.S. Air Force VC-135B aircraft. Many of the flights are very long and the plane will be full or nearly so on every leg, so carry-on items should be limited. Overseas purchases that do not fit in your baggage should be mailed home—there is no extra cargo space. Because interior aircraft temperatures may vary from warm to cool, and because of the length of the flights, plan to dress casually on travel days in something adaptable to differing climates.

The Control Room/Staff Office established in each hotel will be the focal point of staff work and for information and assistance. It will be a fully-equipped office. In addition, personnel in the Control Room/Staff Office will be able to provide currency exchange, bottled water, liquor purchase (where appropriate), restaurant-shopping-sightseeing advice, electrical transformers, classified-document security (do not leave classified items unattended in your room), tennis court reservations, and a variety of other services which may differ from city to city.






