The purpose of this submission is to establish rule 5 to cover the emergency generator inventory records. These records are required for five years in order to observe a trend in load increase or decrease. This trend can be used to predict when the generator will require replacement. The generator must be replaced if the load exceeds rated capacity or if it drops below 25% of rated capacity.
