1	Rule 3. Disposition of intern and resident individual training records is increased from 30 years to 50 years. Air Force medical facilities and schools are still receiving requests from civilian hospitals for verification of individuals who completed residency and internship training in 1953 and later. If prior 1953 training records are destroyed, it could result in withheld credentials and/or denial of privileges for some medical professionals. Considering that medical professionals could begin training at an Air Force medical facility or school at age 25, they would still be practicing medicine at age 55 and may need verification of their medical training.
