Background Army Field Support Battalion-SouthWest Asia-Logistics, a subordinate of the 402d Army Field Support Brigade and US Army Sustainment Command, is requesting authorization for early on-site disposal of Theater Provided Equipment (TPE) reconciled property records. The existing disposition requires the records be destroyed 6 years after the property is turned in or destroyed. After discussions between functional subject matter experts, the command historian and the command records manager, the consensus is it would not be practical or viable to digitize or transfer these records to meet remaining retention period as the workload and cost involved would be significant and outweigh the benefits. All document registers for reconciled records can be retrieved electronically through the Army's web-based combat service support property accountability system PBUSE (Property Book Unit Supply Enhanced)  This request for early disposal applies to the 401st & 402nd Army Field Support Brigades in Itaa/Afghanistan during their 2011 end of four duty drawing down more than 7 years of combat and theater sustainment equipment.
