In the attached SF115, Request for Records Disposition Authority, the Department of the Army proposes permanent retention of Counterintelligence(CI)Collection Files(FN503-01).

Records consist of instructions on the selection and procurement of CI information. Included are schedules for collections and liaison with organizational elements of the intelligence system on collection requirements. Records are created in support of the Army's CI program involving investigations of hostile foreign intelligence activities, military/civilian personnel, and industrial security matters.
