These records document the monthly radiation doses measured on Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory employees, visitors and guests. Each employee or guest working around ionizing radiation wears a film badge on the upper torso. After the end of every month, the film badge is sent to the Personal Dosimetry Office of Environment, Health and Saftey (EH&S), where the radiation dose is calculated and recorded. The individual then receives a new film badge for the month.

This series is arranged chronologically and then by employee badge number. The badges measure 1" x 2" with an identifyingnumber perforation on one end. The index to these badges remains in the Personal Dosimetry Office.

This series is administratively valuable, since the film badges will be needed by health physicists and epidemiologists to study the results of work near ionizing radiation. The records also will be needed to substantiate possible legal claims of excessive radiation exposure.

The series was transferred to San Bruno in 1975. Upon the request of the Federal Record Center (FRC), the records were removed because the Department of Energy (DOE) Schedule 1324.2 required that the records be disposed in one year. LBL knowing the value or the records did not permit the records to be disposed. The records then were transferred to a commercial storage company. After several years, due to budget constraints, the records were transferred to LBL in 1981 and placed in a warehouse. The Archives and Records Office requests permission to transfer these records to the Federal Records Center promptly.

The records exhibit "vinegar-syndrome." They are outgasing acidic acid.
