National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) Case System

NIBIN is a national databank of both projectile and cartridge information NIBIN is the integration of two previous systems the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Drugfire cartridge case imaging system and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives' (ATF) Integrated Ballistic Identification System (IBIS) NIBIN is an imaging system that allows both bullets and cartridges recovered from a crime scene to be compared electronically against other bullets and cartridges recovered from previous crime scenes, in an effort to link previously unrelated criminal cases

The NIBIN Case System (NCS) consists of state and local law enforcement police reports related to crimes involving firearms where the crimes have been linked using NIBIN. A summary of the report is entered by contractors into NCS to provide narrative linkage between firearms used in crimes. The data consists of the police department, date of incident, incident narrative, persons involved, and information on the firearm used. This information can be used by state and local law enforcement agencies to link a firearm to a crime and to an individual. NCS includes 20,000 reports and 4,500 to 6,000 are added each year.

Masterfile.

The masterfile consists of hit records which are incident reports of crimes where the same firearm is used. A hit is a linkage between criminal cases, not individual pieces of evidence. Multiple bullets and/or casings may be entered as part of the same case record, in this event, each discovered linkage to an additional criminal case constitutes a hit. The information comes from state and local law enforcement police reports. Fields include information on the firearm make, number, description, crime type, incident narrative, persons involved, and police department reporting the incident.
