Request authority for immediate disposal described as follows: (1) The remains of 1040, 1120, 1120S, 940 and 941 Income Tax Returns all of which were involved in the Glendale Office, Los Angeles District fire which took place on March 3, 1986. (2) These records have been inspected by managers and whatever could have been salvaged has already been extracted and/or copied. Management has already made decisions as to what audits will be continued and what audits will be discontinued. (3) These records are very brittle and contain an undesirable odor from the fire and smoke, thus making them useless. (4) The volume of these records is approximately 80 cubic feet.
