Public Law 92-224 (96 Stat. 243), a joint resolution dated July 28, 1982, authorized the construction of the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial, in accordance with the plans selected by the Commission, in West Potomac Park, Washington, D.C.

The commission dissolved in 1997.
