The sugar import programs are designed to make U.S. manufacturers of sugar-containing products equal competitors in the world market, make it easier for domestic refiners to export refined sugar into the world market, and to provide world priced sugar to U.S. manufacturers of polyhydric alcohols. These programs regulate and promote the import of commodities into the U.S. for re-exporting, transferring, or manufacturing use.		
	a. Sugar Imports Subject to Licensing Requirements.		
	Records consist of applications for licenses, any amendments, letters of approval or disapproval, certifications of affiliation, surety bonds and/or letters of credit, documentation agreements, reports and any other related correspondence and background materials.
