

RG 166 - Department of Agriculture, Foreign Agricultural Service

The Foreign Agricultural Service has primary responsibility for the development of foreign markets for U.S. agricultural products. Export and foreign food assistance programs are administered under Public Law 480, the Agricultural Trade Development and Assistance Act of 1954, as amended (7 U.S.C. 1691) and the Food for Peace Act of 1966 (7 U.S.C. 1691). Under these authorities, agricultural commodities are supplied and exported to combat hunger and malnutrition and to encourage economic development in the developing countries.

1 - Interagency Staff Committee - Mailings and Written Determinations (1954-1967)

These records consist of high level original and carbon copies of correspondence and all other papers created or received as evidence of U.S. crop exports authorized under Public Law 480, the Whitten Amendment and Mutual Security Act (Public Law 665). Memoranda document Secretary approval of non-price support crops, changes in PL 480 and in some instances, grants and financing provided for commodity requests. These records document the supply, demand and Agency position for commodities requested and include: original spreadsheets, approval memos, copies of the International Cooperation Administration Bulletin as well as meeting minutes of the Interagency Staff Committee, which approved commodity requests. Mailings are comprised of memoranda, charts and other materials which were distributed during Interagency Staff Committee meetings. Arranged chronologically by year.

Disposition: Permanent. Transfer to National Archives upon approval of this schedule.

Justification: Records relate to the execution of the agency's mission to market and develop agricultural products abroad.
