



1	The Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 USC 1501 et seq.) created the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) on February 16, 1938, within the Department of Agriculture. The headquarters office is in Washington, D. C. Both the Actuarial Division which devises actuarial/underwriting policies of the Corporation and the National Service Office which conducts the accounting function for the Corporation are in Kansas City, MO. FCIC also has offices for individual states or groups of states and offices for individual counties or groups of counties which sell the insurance policies, collect the premiums, and service the contracts.
