These files consists of a Report of Apparent Violation, compliance history, photographs, invoices, labels, shipping papers, storage records, bills of lading, detentions, surveillance reports, laboratory reports, signed statements, organizational structures, letters of warning, and any administrative or criminal proceeding initiated.

#### DESCRIPTION OF RECORDS

Meat and/or Poultry Investigation/Violation records can be referred to the Office of General Counsel or the Office of United States Attorney for legal action. They can also be closed with a letter of warning from Compliance Program. These case files fall into seven categories:

a. Prosecution Case Files With A Criminal Conviction

Meat and/or Poultry violation case files that conclude with a prosecution.

- 1. <u>Record Copy</u> Destroy 10 years after the end of the fiscal year that the case was closed.
- 2. Other copies Destroy when 1 year old.
- b. Prosecution or other Case Files With An Administrative Order

Meat and/or Poultry violation case files that result in an Administrative Order.

- 1. <u>Record Copy</u> Destroy 1 year after the end of the fiscal year that the Administrative Order terminated.
- 2. Other Copies Destroy when 1 year old.
- c. <u>Case Files that are Precedent Setting</u>/Significant amendment added per

Meat and/or Poultry violation case files that project a new or existing standard or policy, or have gained national attention because of significant news media or Congressional interest. 1. <u>Record Copy</u>

Permanent. Offer to NARA 10 years after the end of the fiscal year that the case was closed.

- e. Injunction Case Files

Case files that concern firms or individuals that have been enjoined from selling or handling meat and poultry products because of violations of the FMIA or PPIA.

- 1. <u>Record Copy</u> Destroy 1 year after the end of the fiscal year that the termination order occurred.
- 2. <u>Other Copies</u> Destroy when 1 year old.

#### f. Pretrial Diversion Case Files

Case files of firms that have entered a pretrial diversion agreement because of violations of the FMIA or PPIA.

1. <u>Record Copy</u> Destroy 1 year after the end of the fiscal year that the termination order occurred. See 3a


