	<p>The Geographic Base File is a map in a form that can be read by a computer. Dual Independent Map Encoding is a method of representing map features numerically for processing by computer. The GBF are computerized versions of the metropolitan map series plus street segment ranges, zip codes, and X-4 coordinate values at intersections. Each record in the files identifies a segment of a feature on a map by its node points, address, and the geographic unit identified on both sides. Records for non-street map features such as railroads, streams, and political boundaries are included. A set of nodes noted and numbered metropolitan maps corresponding to area for all areas are included.</p> <p>1 tape per SMSA (larger SMSAs require 3 to 4 reels)</p> <p>Disposition: PERMANENT.
